

ON THIS DATE (1989) – GIDUPPKA came into Canterbury Downs as a low claimer in 1989. On September 17, 1989, he won a 20,000 claiming race for his fifth win in a row at the Shakopee oval moving up the claiming ladder each time. Trained by 3-time leading trainer Pat Cuccurullo, Giduppka was voted as 1989 Champion Claiming Horse of the Year.

Nice win last out in the same fashion of her win 3 back here on the turf. She sat off the pace in both and then romped in the lane. Form very good at the moment and will get an honest pace to close into. First 2 turf starts were at SA at over 35-1 odds.

He won this race in 2017 with second time starter Amy's Challenge also beating males with that filly. (She turned out to be a G1 runner). 2 nd in last won MSW by 15 next. A) 3,6 B) 1,2 C) 4,5	PICK: 6 THE TABULATOR Very difficult race. This one gets the nod based on how well he has run fresh. He won 4 of 5 either off a layoff or in the career debut. 100 Beyer in start 2 back stands out. Runner-up won back in op clm 75k next and had been 2 nd a nose in the CC Express. VALUE: 5 KELLER'S GOLD Think there might be something here. His 2 starts off the layoff show the form he had back when he was running in stakes a few years ago. Gave one of the main players a serious test in last when 2 nd to King of the Court. Trainer is having a huge meet. She does have some backclass (stakes placed at DED two years ago). Leading trainer drops in here for the victory. VALUE: 4 TIME FOR KISSES Finally got a fast track in last and the public was on her in a 2-1 win at 4k claiming. She has hit the board in 7 straight on a fast track.
