VALUE: 7 PORTRAIT Interesting filly for top level trainer Brad Cox. She's been favored in all 3 starts. Slow start in debut on turf at Ellis Park. Added blinkers and move to the main track resulted in a huge 12 length win. Better than last start. VALUE: 10 ENFORCEABLE No one has the pedigree this one has. His dam produced the 2013 BC Juv winner New Year's Day, 4x grade 2 winner Mohaymen and G3 winner Kingly. VALUE: 7 TONE BROKE Ran 2 nd to King for a Day five back at Pimlico and that one came back to beat Maximum Security in his next start. Didn't run his race in the \$1M Derby last out. VALUE: 9 MIDNIGHT TEA TIME Moved to synthetic in last at TP and ran a flat fourth moving from a wide 6 path. Last time Beschizza was up was 3 back and it produced a win at 4-1 at KD.
