

ON THIS DATE (1985) – On June 30, 1985, Canterbury Downs was just 5 days old. The 2nd race that day was a non-descript maiden race won by **BYE FOR NOW**. The Arizona-bred won the race in :40 seconds flat for about 3 ½ furlongs. What makes it unique is that it is the longest standing Canterbury track record. Bye For Now won once more in a 6-race career.

She was in tight early, tried to get out a bit on the turn and was 6-wide before finally running on. Dam was multiple stakes placed in Chicago. Breezing work a week ago. VALUE: 1 SUMMER SWINGER Trainer looking for his first career win and might get it here. This is a first timer with nice breeding for a Mn-bred. Dam won the '13 Minnesota Distaff Sprint and earned 173K in her career. This filly was entered in the MTA Stakes on 6/23 but scratched for this spot. Will be closing late. VALUE: 4 MILLARD'S COMET Claimed in last when she was beaten as the 1-2 fav vs similar. This is the third time she was claimed in just five career starts. Ran 2 nd in last but was clear of 3 rd . The rider Negron has had a strong start here with over 24% winners. Should press the pace here. Third ran a big 3rd in the Sampson Oaks at 17-1. 5 th won back at 7-1. VALUE: 5 FIRSTMATE She was the upset winner of the Mn Turf Distaff on the move from the Lady Slipper to the turf race 2 nd off the layoff. But it took a long time for the connections to drop him to this level. Dwelt and off slow in a few of the starts at OP this year. Has nibbled vs better. Drop will help some. Just 3k sire fee but sold for 110k. Blinkers removed for this start and moves to the turf. Notice the 58.4 gate drill a week ago. Will likely see much more from him here. Drops in half for this one. VALUE: 6 ME SAY SO Thought he would run well on the class drop in most recent start but finished a bad last. The last time this 7YO gelding ran on a firm turf was a win at LAD 4 back vs a similar looking field. There's a lot of speed in this race and it will be won by rider who is able to save something in the lane. Gets one of the top jockeys aboard for high percentage outfit.

VALUE: 9 MESA SKYLINE

He's pretty honest for this level. He's hit the board in 8 of 14 on this turf including last out when third at 6-1. He's run well in 3 of the last 4 starts. There is enough speed to set up a late run from well off the pace. Just as he did 2 back and nearly won it at 43-1.

Trainer Ed Ross Hardy is first in all-time wins (347) and all-time earnings (3.7M) in quarterhorse races here at CBY. He can win with a first timer. This one is well-bred. Dam won her debut and lone sibling also won his debut. Quick works at RP and at PRM.

VALUE: 4 THE WICKED FROG

Was down towards the inside in his debut at RP in April. The runner to his outside came over on him in the early stages and forced him inside and lost a lot of momentum. Had a good work prior at RP. He should improve in second start with a clean break.

The owners of this 8YO mare have had this one off and on over the years and had much success with her (won the 2017 Princess Elaine). Traffic issues in the last two starts. Nice run at 11-1 at TAM 3 back at this distance. She's 2 for 4 at this 5F distance at CBY.

VALUE: 2 PURPLE SCOOTER

4YO Goldencents filly has been on the turf 3 times. She was 2nd twice and the race off the board was in a 25k claimer with blinkers on, no Lasix. Went wire to wire in the 8 length win two back but don't think she needs the lead. Could be overlooked in this one.

Nice debut at RP when 2nd at nearly 12-1. She broke sharp, right on top, and was just outfinished by the 6-5 favorite who was coming in off a neck defeat in another RP maiden race. 4th from there ran 3rd in a trial here at 5-2 next. Dam earned 328k in her career.

VALUE: 6 SCOUTS ON FIRE

Claimed out of her debut in a race where she went off at around 8-1 and was eliminated at the break. Was 15-1 here and ran a huge race for second back of a 2-5 winner that ran away from the field. Makes her second start for a trainer having a strong meet.
