ON THIS DATE (1985) – On June 30, 1985, Canterbury Downs was just 5 days old. The 2nd race that day was a non-descript maiden race won by BYE FOR NOW. The Arizona-bred won the race in :40 seconds flat for about 3 ½ furlongs. What makes it unique is that it is the longest standing Canterbury track record. Bye For Now won once more in a 6-race career.
