<b>4<sup>th</sup> MSW 50K, 1M TURF 59</b> 7 SYLVANELLA 4-1 9 MIMINA'S TEAM 5-1 8 HIGHLAND GLORY 6-1 2 SCAPE 15-1 <b>PICK: 7 SYLVANELLA</b> Trainer had one first time grass starter routing in MSW for this owner. That was in December and it won at 7-1 with this rider up. Works (also at Payson) similar to this one. Dam was a stakes winner. <b>VALUE: 9 MIMINA'S TEAM</b> Took a bit of action in the debut but did zero running. That was on the dirt. Was flying late after a bad break on grass in last to get into a 4-way photo. Dam half to the 8x G1 turf winner \$4.5M, Falbrav. A) 7,8,9 B) 2,10,12 C) 3,4,5,6,11	<b>5<sup>th</sup> CLM 12K, 1M DIRT 37</b> 6 KRACHENWAGEN 7-2 5 THIRD ARMY 5-2 1 CHASE RUNNER 6-1 4 ZIPPY 2-1 <b>PICK: 6 KRACHENWAGEN</b> This is a pretty big drop in class for this shipper from Canada. He was 4 <sup>th</sup> of 7 in his last start for opt clm 40k and might have run better had he not been cutoff in the race. Doesn't face much in here. <b>VALUE: 1 CHASE RUNNER</b> Really looked sharp in both career wins for this outfit. Broke his maiden at TAM by 13 lengths and fired a career best at GPW two back in an 8-1 score. Drops out of op clm and gets the cozy inside post. A) 5,6 B) 1,2,4 C) 3	<b>6<sup>th</sup> MSW 50K, 1M TURF 61</b> 4 TOMORRA 9-2 2 MARSH HARBOUR 12-1 12 CAMELLIA GAL 15-1 8 PEARLESCENT 5-1 <b>PICK: 4 TOMORRA</b> Exits a key race. 3 of the top 4 finishers have come back to run and all won. The winner took 100k Ginger Brew. Sib to the \$1.8M turf winner, Catch a Glimpse. Better post and gets top rider up, Ortiz. <b>VALUE: 2 MARSH HARBOUR</b> Other Ortiz lands here for McGaughey. Turf was always the plan. Dam was only turf and won 780k for Shug. Ortiz is 37% for this trainer here at GP and this one gets L1 today. Expect big improvement. A) 2,4,12 B) 6,7,8 C) 1,3,5,9,10,11	<b>7<sup>th</sup> CLM 16K, 1M TURF 55</b> 12 RIVERT EVANGELIST 12-1 5 FLOWMOTION 6-1 7 HOT AND HEAVY 8-1 3 TIL THE END 7-2 <b>PICK: 12 RIVER EVANGELIST</b> Trainer 39% with one off a layoff of over 6 mo's. But 4 for 4 (100%) with a break of 420 - 450 days (as this one has) and that includes a 7-1 win 2 weeks ago for this owner. Is protected from the claim. <b>VALUE: 5 FLOWMOTION</b> Pushed too hard, too early, into a quick pace set by the winner and tired late to lose a three-way photo for 2 <sup>nd</sup> . Big rider move to Irad Ortiz. He was the rider for his last win (this level here with 90 fig). A) 5,12 B) 3,4,7,10 C) 1,2,6,8,9,11
<b>8<sup>th</sup> CLM 8K, 6F DIRT 47</b> 1 FOLLOWHISFOOTSTEPS 9-2 2 RAYO MY KING 2-1 6 FRANK ALONE 4-1 8 MILLIONAIRE RUNNER 10-1 <b>PICK: 1 FOLLOWHISFOOTSTEPS</b> Trainer is an insane 46 for 98 (47%) first off the claim (and 4 for 6 in such for this owner). In addition, he's 7 for 12 (58%) first off the claim with one who won the prior race. Keeps winning rider Saez up. <b>VALUE: 6 FRANK ALONE</b> Tried going long off a good 10-1 placing two back. He was part of the pace that went :45.4 for the half and he tired from those early efforts. 4 next out winners from 3 back race. Very playable in here. A) 1,2,6 B) 5,8 C) 3,7,9,10	<b>9<sup>th</sup> ALLW 51K, 1M 1/16 TURF 44</b> 7 BOURBON IN MAY 3-1 8 KADAR 5-2 5 MANTRA 8-1 3 LARGENT 9-2 <b>PICK: 7 BOURBON IN MAY</b> High percentage team of Pletcher and Castellano here. This one won his last 2 starts and just missed in the two prior. He's placed smartly in this allowance. Appears this the right distance for him. <b>VALUE: 5 MANTRA</b> Was loaded in last but got stuck behind a wall of runners. He weaved through a bunch of traffic to get within two at the end. Been in the exacta in 4 of 8 on this turf course. Is overdue for second win. A) 7,8 B) 2,3,5,9,10 C) 4,6	<b>10<sup>th</sup> OPT CLM 16K, 6F DIRT 82</b> 5 LET'S BE HONEST 3-1 9 DIENDA 6-1 8 SAYONARA BABY 5-2 4 DANCING DESTROYER 6-1 <b>PICK: 5 LET'S BE HONEST</b> Big effort two back when 2 <sup>nd</sup> to a runner who came back to win a 75k stakes by 9 lengths here (89 fig) and is undefeated 3 for 3. Good 5 <sup>th</sup> in a 400k 3 back. Winner ran in BC JuvF & won a 125k at Tam Sat. <b>VALUE: 9 DIENDA</b> Banking that the statebred stakes she is coming out of are just stronger races than others in here have been in. Ortiz takes the mount for the first time here for Casse and working well for a return. A) 5 B) 3,4,8,9 C) 2,6,7	<b>10<sup>th</sup> MSW 50K, 1M 1/16 TURF 62</b> 1 NORTH BROADWAY 7-2 10 TAKE TEN 10-1 6 ELLE M'A SOURI 4-1 2 IN FRONT 5-2 <b>PICK: 1 NORTH BROADWAY</b> Dam half to '14 BC Juvenile Turf winner (and 850k earner) Hootenanny. Brown firster working well. Brown is 10 for 27 (37%) with a debut turfer in MSW for this owner (and he is 2 for 2 with this rider). <b>VALUE: 10 TAKE TEN</b> Pace dependent closer and she didn't get much to run into in either start last two at AQU. The winner of last was able to go wire to wire. Went 8 wide in start two back. Consider w/ an honest pace. A) 1,10 B) 2,4,6 C) 5,7,8,9
