Routed two back and ran ok for her first route. Fit nicely at this level 3, 4 back. Winner 4 back won for 10k and 2 nd in op clm since. Will be closing late here. VALUE: 6 RIDE LADY RIDE Was competitive at this level last year in 3 starts and even ran well vs better later on. But she's been off since April with a spotty worktab. To make matters worse this trainer had just one win in 2019 and is 0 for 22 this year. Win chance if ready. He's been gelded since. Cal-bred is bred for turf. Dam a sib to 2014 G3 Early Times Mint Julep turf winner Honey Hues (won 4 of 9 on turf, 150k). Sharp local drill. VALUE: 1 YHA YHA Has a bit of pedigree. The 2nd dam is a half to the show finisher in the 2001 Ky Derby, Congaree. He won over \$3.2M for Bob Baffert. Gets credit in his last start for having to close into a slow pace. His first two starts in So Cal are not terrible. A) 5,6 B) 1,2,4,7 C) 3	3 MDN CLM 7K, 5F DIRT 64 9 CUSHMAN ROAD 2-1 8 ANXIOUSLY ENGAGED 15-1 5 ROSES FOR DOUG 5-2 2 THECHAMPISFLORING 6-1 PICK: 9 CUSHMAN ROAD Deserving favorite in here after she had two runner-up finishes vs similar at HST and TUP. 5 th from debut won back for a mdn clm 25k level at HST. She beat four of the foes in here in her last start. She should be tough w/ a clean break today. VALUE: 8 ANXIOUSLY ENGAGED This trainer is having a good meet (has won 11 times from 54 starts for 20% hit rate). He's 4 for 7 with a debut runner in mdn clm for 10k or less at TUP. He had such winner for this owner with Lindsay up 6 days ago. He went wire to wire at 7-2. A) 8,9 B) 2,4,5 C) 1,6,7	4 CLM 3K, 6.5F DIRT 59 10 MIGIWEWIN 12-1 7 SILVANUS 5-2 4 NORM'S PLACE 7-5 6 SOLAR HEAT 20-1 PICK: 10 MIGIWEWIN Just got under the cutoff for conditions for last win (by 13 days). The last 2 years he won the 1st time he was in a claiming race. Reared at the start in last and was off slow. Rider has been up for 4 of his 7 wins. Has been able to show speed, too. VALUE: 7 SILVANUS 11YO gelding comes in off a long layoff (last out in March). The conditions allow for a one who hasn't won since Feb 18 th '19. This one last won on Feb 16 th '19. He won back to back starts at this level last year. May need a race or two for his best. A) 4,7,10 B) 1,6,8,9 C) 3,5
5 OPT CLM 10K, 6F DIRT 61 4 SON OF ELEANOR 6-1 8 BANDWIDTH 9-2 3 SERENGETI CAT 5-1 7 CREATIVE ART 3-1 PICK: 4 SON OF ELEANOR He's been an absolute win machine for these connections. They claimed him 14 starts ago for 3k. He's won 8 of 13 starts since. Broke last at 2F in his last start as a 2-1 second choice. Has speed but can finish. Rider up for all 8 wins since claim. VALUE: 8 BANDWIDTH Closer figures to get a fast pace in here. He was moving best late in the last out but ran out of time at 5.5F. Has been in the win mix late in 8 consecutive starts. Has run well at the distance and here at Turf Paradise. Wide late move for Stevens. A) 3,4,8 B) 1,7,9 C) 2,5,6	6 CLM 3K, 3.5F DIRT 26 6 ANGELS N DEVILDOGS 9-2 9 SHE GOT AWAY 3-1 2 GATHAN'S GIRL 7-2 7 R U TOUGH ENOUGH 10-1 PICK: 6 ANGELS N DEVILDOGS Drew the rail in her last start and broke dead last of 9 runners. Stevens rushed her up to grab the lead before she tired late. Not much confirmed speed in here and that could give her a shot to control it throughout. Just 2 nd time at this level. VALUE: 7 R U TOUGH ENOUGH Shipped from the tougher Golden Gate circuit last out. She ran evenly as a 7-1 chance. Three of the four runners who have run back from that race ran in the money. Faced and beat better in No Cal. Might get a good stalking trip in this one. A) 2,6,7,9 B) 3,5 C) 1,4,8	7 CLM 4K, 5F DIRT 48 6 MITCH AND JOHN E 8-1 8 DRAYMAGIC 4-1 1 REDROCK TRAIL 8-1 7 HOT RODIN 3-1 PICK: 6 MITCH AND JOHN E This will come down to who trips out in here. There is a ton of speed and many that are need-the-lead types. This one is going to be in a great stalking trip. This rider move is big. He beat the one to his outside in opt clm 2 back. Gets the trip. VALUE: 8 DRAYMAGIC It's worth noting that the #10 Hurricane Force, a major player on paper, was vet scratched since his last start. This one has run well here (9 for 9 in the money with 4 wins). He'll get a fast pace to fire in the lane. Rider 3 wins in last 4 on him. A) 6,8 B) 1,4,5,7,9 C) 3,10	8 CLM 40K, 1M TURF 26 9 SKYCHIEF 9-2 7 NUDIAMOND 8-1 10 I'M AN EIGHT 8-1 6 SIX POINT RACK 10-1 PICK: 9 SKYCHIEF Stevens had some options here and he decided to stay here. That is important since he has 19 turf wins and the rest of the field combined has just 30. Traffic 2 back cost him a win. Game in the win in last start. Gets a perfect race flow today. VALUE: 7 NUDIAMOND He's been on the turf once. That was in the start five back. He won the race but was DQ'd afterwards due to a positive test. Has run well since that race except for the easing finish in last. Appears to be enough speed to set him up late today. A) 2,6,7,9,10 B) 1,3,4,5 C) 8
