She showed a bit of speed before stopping. She might have bled in there as she gets first time Lasix in here. The winner won the G1 Del Mar Debutante next and another G2 in the start after that. Has a couple of sharp 5F breezes.  <b>VALUE: 2 MY MY MUNNY</b> Bred to sprint on both sides of the family. She was on the inside in the debut and flashed speed before she tired in the lane beating one horse home. Catalano is better with 2 <sup>nd</sup> and 3 <sup>rd</sup> time starters and the move to Geroux means he's serious. Expecting a bit more here. Sib to the G1 sprinter, Shancelot. Winner of last ran 3 <sup>rd</sup> in the Street Sense next out. Lasix for 1 <sup>st</sup> time. When Asmussen has very fast works with a slow breeze 6 days out, he's live.  <b>VALUE: 1 MY HONEY'S PERFECT</b> Claimed for 50k last time out. Diodoro is excellent off the claim and particularly with maidens. He's won 5x with maidens first off the claim here at OP. Second in that race came back to run 2 <sup>nd</sup> again at 50k for the 4 <sup>th</sup> runner-up finish in a row. Has a blazing worktab here. A) 5,8    B) 1,2,6    C) 3,4,9

Only 2 losses and there were excuses in both. Sloppy track 4 back and wicked pace in the G3 Dogwood (made early move in there). She sold for 55 times the 5,000 sire fee.  <b>VALUE: 1 WILDWOOD'S BEAUTY</b> She always seems to run a big race and often will fire despite the long odds. Was less than 4 behind one of the main players here, Frank's Rockette, in the 150k stakes 3 back. 7 for 7 in the money at the distance and 3 for 3 in the money at OP. Notice that 4/2 bullet work. He had run but was very badly stopped many times in the lane. Dam won 1.5M mostly sprinting (7x graded stakes winner). Rider won the Pippin here for Jones and this ownership last year.  <b>VALUE: 9 SKIP INTRO</b> Ran well enough in both of his starts as a 2YO. Split a good field in the debut. 4 runners from that race ran 1 <sup>st</sup> or 2 <sup>nd</sup> in their comeback including the winner who was 3rd in the 75k Sugar Bowl at FG 2 starts later. <b>5 – OAKLAWN PARK (3:15 ET)</b> <b>OPT CLM 20K, 1M 1/16 DIRT</b>  <b>3 BANDIT POINT</b> 12-1 <b>HARR</b> 5 TRUCULENT      4-1 <b>ARRIETA</b> 8 IMPOSSIBLE TASK      3-1 <b>ROSARIO</b> 9 SUPER CONSTITUTION      5-1 <b>CANCHARI</b>  <b>PICK: 3 BANDIT POINT</b> Hard knocking 6YO is the star of this low percentage barn. He has been a late running sprinter of late but has run well going long in the past. Seems to run best with Kelsie Harr in the saddle (she won her first ever ride with him at CBY). 3 of her 4 wins came here at OP.  <b>VALUE: 9 SUPER CONSTITUTION</b> Alex Canchari was aboard for the wire to wire win as a 9-5 favorite last time out. Likely to be sent from wide post draw today. Bred to go long with the Constitution influence. Dam won \$1M mostly routing (was 2 <sup>nd</sup> in G1 Apple Blossom here in 2009). <b>8 – OAKLAWN PARK (5:09 ET) 48</b> OPT CLM 50K, 6F DIRT  <b>7 SHASHASHAKEMEUP</b> <b>3-1</b> <b>GEROUX</b> 1 SECRET COURIER                      6-1    COHEN 9 ONE FOR RICHIE                      7-2    ARRIETA 8 DIGITAL                      7-2    SAEZ, G  <b>PICK: 7 SHASHASHAKEMEUP</b> Lone start on this track produced a 50-1 upset a year ago at this distance. Claimed by a trainer who excels with new acquisitions like this and he already got G2 placing out of him last out. 4 <sup>th</sup> from the G3 Palos Verdes (Ax Man) won the Santana Mile easily next out (95 Beyer).  <b>VALUE: 1 SECRET COURIER</b> Claimed three back by this high percentage outfit. He won first off the claim here despite a poor start. Had front wraps on from the race claimed out of but didn't have them first off the claim. Wide trip pressing fast fractions in last. Inside post will be an advantage here. Was a long price in the G1 BC Dirt Mile and split the field in a tough race. Winner won the G1 Pegasus next and 2 <sup>nd</sup> won CC Jewel before running 2 <sup>nd</sup> again to Knicks Go in the Pegasus. Clockers very high on his worktab for this.  <b>VALUE: 2 GUN IT</b> Has \$15M winner Gun Runner and \$4.5M winner Saint Liam in this female family. He's run well enough some of the time but hasn't lived up to that breeding. Does deserve credit for closing into what was a slow pace set by Blackberry Wine in last. Might be an overlay here. A) 4,6    B) 2,5    C) 1,3,7,8,9	<b>10 – OAKLAWN PARK (6:29 ET) 50</b> OPT CLM 75K, 6F DIRT  <b>1 NAME REJECTED</b> <b>7-2</b> <b>GARCIA</b> 7 MIGHTY MISCHIEF                      2-1    SANTANA 5 UPSTRIKER                      8-1    TALAMO 2 GAME DAY PLAY                      7-2    SAEZ, G  <b>PICK: 1 NAME REJECTED</b> Only ran one bad race and that was in his debut on a wet track and the only time he had blinkers on. Had a wide trip three back and may have bled 4 back. Broke through last time out despite a bad steady late in the race. Garcia sticks here. Will likely be sent from the rail.  <b>VALUE: 5 UPSTRIKER</b> Blew the doors off the field in the debut at ELP and it was good enough for the connections to try a G1 next time out. Winner of the G1 Breeders' Futurity is undefeated and will be a favorite in the Ky Derby. Has Lasix here which could explain the poor effort in last. A) 1,5,7    B) 2,3,4    C) 6,8,9
<b>11 – OAKLAWN PARK (7:05 ET) 72</b> COUNT FLEET-G3 500K, 6F DIRT  <b>5 EMPIRE OF GOLD</b> <b>8-1</b> <b>CABRERA</b> 2 WHITMORE                      9-5    SANTANA 6 CZ ROCKET                      2-1    GEROUX 1 NO PAROLE                      9-2    VAZQUEZ  <b>PICK: 5 EMPIRE OF GOLD</b> Confident placing off the layoff here. Outran his odds in both of the graded stakes at KEE. Deserves a lot of credit for pressing and setting the pace in the Sprint last out and was less than a length behind CZ Rocket for 2 <sup>nd</sup> . Can stalk which puts him in a gravy spot today.  <b>VALUE: 1 NO PAROLE</b> Tried the turf in last and lost all chance when he was left at the gate. Grade 1 winner on dirt five starts ago for Thomas Amoss. Obviously major speed player out of the rail box draw. Earned a 97 Beyer in only sprint at this track. He could be tough to run down in the lane. Looks like virtually all of the Baffert runners these days. He's undefeated, a speedball and will be a player in the Ky Derby. Major win in the Rebel when he was sent into a speed duel early, won the battle and the war. Low priced favorite.  <b>VALUE: 1 SUPER STOCK</b> Drew wide in the Rebel and was giving up recency to a lot of the field in there. It was roughly run in the lane and he took the brunt of it. Might end up being a very fast pace and wouldn't be surprised if it melted down in deep stretch. He'll be saving ground with a late run. Didn't care for the outside post and the slow pace two back and he couldn't really close into it late. Huge rider move here to Geroux (28% at the meet). Will get pace to run into.  <b>VALUE: 7 NOMADIC FIGHTER</b> Breeding is all route and he gets another chance at a longer distance here. Debut was a flop but Asmussen is better second out with a MSW router. He put 3 drills into him since the debut. Goes to his top call rider in here Santana. Slow drill is a good sign for this trainer.
