Dropped in class and won in last in a strong effort and he was claimed out of that race. Trainer is not having a great meet but will heat up soon. Won starter allowance at OP in Feb. There's a lot of turf in female family. <b>VALUE: 4 J.E.'S HANDMEDOWN</b> Exits one of the real key races run at this meet so far. The winner came back and ran second by a nose in a 50k stakes on July 1 <sup>st</sup> . Third won in the same condition by 10 lengths. 8 <sup>th</sup> won an IA-bred 15k by 7 next. First grass, so that is the question. She had a slower work on July 12 but that was a muddy track. Since 2016, Van Winkle is 7 of 12 in the money (2 wins at 6-1 & 14-1) with a first timer 2Y0 in MSW here at CBY. <b>VALUE: 9 MINNESOTA NICE</b> Firster brought a price of \$41,000 at the Minneota August sale of last year and it is a big price considering the sire fee is at \$2,000. Dam won her debut by over 8 lengths here and took the '08 MN Distaff by 9. Trainer just 3 for 47 with a 1st timer. A) 3,9 B) 4,7 C) 2,8

This one did a bit of the heavy lifting early before tiring as they all did behind the winner. Her form at OP is good enough to win this. Rider an up-and-comer. Is 4 for 5 in money at CBY. <b>VALUE: 7 DUSTY PRINCESS</b> Came off the layoff and started at 5F on the dirt. That distance is too sharp for her as she is a late runner going long. Gets an extra furlong here and a weaker group to catch. Rider gets a second chance after slow break in last. Should be running on. Off slowly from the rail in the start here two back. He finished ok for 4 <sup>th</sup> beaten just 3. Last not great but had the 8 post. Sire won stakes on turf. Bred to handle the grass. <b>VALUE: 6 MS KELA TIME</b> First three starts produced three second place finishes. Probably should've won her 2nd start but had all kinds of trouble in there. Broke dead last in the last start that many of these are out of. She passed quite a few for 4 <sup>th</sup> . Breeding avg. for turf. A) 6,8,10 B) 1,2,9 C) 3,5,7	<b>CANTERBURY PARK R9 (8:40 CT) 78</b> MDN CLM 7K, 6.5F DIRT 5 GONE CRUISING 9-5 3 CLARK AND ADDISON 9-2 1 SAMMY'S NUGGET 3-1 7 SIR ZEB0 6-1 <b>PICK: 5 GONE CRUISING</b> Shipped from Will Rogers where he had faced much better company and ran a strong second in a common race won by Circle Me Bert. Trainer has been solid at this track and is doing well at this meet. He will be motoring home in deep stretch. <b>VALUE: 3 CLARK AND ADDISON</b> Faced MSW company last year and those were good races he was in. It's true that he didn't really compete in those but the class drop in last was big. He took some action but had a miserable break and he was 7 behind the top choice. Better here. A) 5 B) 1,3 C) 6,7
<b>CANTERBURY PARK R6 (7:10 CT) 65</b> MSW 30K, 1M TURF 1 WHERE'D THE DAY GO 5-2 10 MR. D'S LEGEND 6-1 9 STAYCATION 15-1 4 MUSKYMAN 15-1 <b>PICK: 1 WHERE'D THE DAY GO</b> Ran ok in the debut last August when he tried open class MSW runners. Ran about two behind the runner-up (who is in this race) last out. Has some turf winners in this pedigree like Neches Dawn who won six times on grass all here at Canterbury. <b>VALUE: 9 STAYCATION</b> Trainer had just one firster start on the turf and it was last month here for these owners and that runner ran a close 4 <sup>th</sup> at 18-1 despite bad break, wide trip.
