DERBY QUEST (C+) working with TWIRLING DERBY (C+) - This team went together from the 5/8 pole, DERBY QUEST inside of TWIRLING DERBY, who wore blinkers: The pair went off in 36.0, both asked in 101.1, doing their best late, a so-so work for both		
MONGOL ALTAI	SA 02/20/21 C	FT 102.2 H
MONGOL ALTAI wore blinkers for this unimpressive five furlong drill, going off ok in 36.2, urged, finishing with nothing left in 102.2, final 1/4 in 26.0, pass on the bottom level maiden claiming router.		

SA 02/14/21 C+ FT 49.1 H
MONGOL ALTAI wore blinkers for this modest half-mile work, splits of 12.1, passing the 1/4 pole in 24.1, tapped leaving the far turn, lightly urged crossing midstretch in 36.2, hand ridden a bit late while tapped along in 49.1, galloping out down to the 7/8 pole in 103.1, not overly impressive

MONGOL ALTAI SA 01/22/21 C FT 49.2 H

MONGOL ALTAI went slower than given in this unimpressive half-mile drill over this dull main track wearing blinkers, going off in 12.1, urged along around the far turn passing the 1/4 pole in 24.2, asked crossing midstretch in 36.4, urged to the wire in 50.0, not impressive.

SA 01/15/21 C+ FT 49.3 H
MONGOL ALTAI went off from the 1/2 mile pole,
opening 1/4 in 24.1. lightly asked in 49.3, a so-so work.

SA 01/09/21 C FT 102.0 H
MONGOL ALTAI wore blinkers for his five furlong work, we picked him up coming to the 3/8 pole, already being ridden along, asked around the far turn, passing the 1/4 pole in 12.1, hand ridden through the stretch, slowing noticeably in 38.2, not impressive. We cannot verify the Official Time, but unless he went off pretty quickly the time appears too fast.

WILSON MONK SA 02/20/21 B FT 100.0 H
ATOMIC DROP (B), WILSON MONK (B) and
GEORGE HERMAN RUTH (C+) - This trio went
together from the 5/8 pole, GEORGE HERMAN RUTH
starting two lengths in front of ATOMIC DROP and five
lengths in front of WILSON MONK, who wore blinkers
with R. Gonzalez up; WILSON MONK made up a length
in 24.1, 36.1, ATOMIC DROP and GEORGE HERMAN
RUTH in 24.2, 36.2, ATOMIC DROP was never asked,
finishing 1/2 length in front in 100.4, a good work, his
best so far.. WILSON MONK was lightly urged, getting
close in 100.1, a good work for the unraced five-year-old
Cal-bred maiden, who can definitely run. GEORGE
HERMAN RUTH was asked along, final time of 101.1,
just ok for the comebacker.

WILSON MONK (B) working with TONY ANN (B-) - This team of unraced horses came out of the gate together, both wearing blinkers, WILSON MONK inside with Gonzalez; TONY ANN broke well, WILSON MONK broke quite slowly, then rushing up to get even in 12.3, WILSON MONK sped away in 24.1, 35.3, TONY ANN chasing in 24.3, 36.1, WILSON MONK was waiting for his workmate to catch up, 1 1/2 lengths in front passing the 1/4 pole in 48.0, TONY ANN, tapped and asked in 48.1, WILSON MONK was niggled, 3/4 length in front when up in 100.2, galloping out two lengths in front to the wire in 113.4 a good work for the five-year-old Cal-bred Midnight Lute homebred, who has obviously had a lot of problems and needs to break much better, but has a lot of run. TONY ANN was asked, 3/4 length back in 100.2, falling back again on the gallop out to the wire in 114.1, an ok work for the homebred Cairo Prince filly.

SA 02/06/21 B FT 59.3 H

WILSON MONK (B) working with IN VRONSKY STYLE (B-) - This team of older, unraced Cal-bred maidens wore blinkers for their first local work, WILSON MOON inside of IN VRONSKY STYLE, who had Pyfer in the irons; The pair went off quickly, fractions of 11.3, 23.0, 34.3, WILSON MONK getting 3/4 in front in 46.3, WILSON MONK was hand ridden, pulling clear to the wire in 59.3, galloping out far in front in 113.3, getting a bit tired, but still a good first work over the track for the five-year-old son of Midnight Lute, who has obviously had trouble getting to the races, but has ability. IN VROKNSKY STYLE got tired while whipped a couple of times, and asked in 100.1, three back at the wire, final furlong in 13.3, ok for the four-year-old homebred Vronsky gelding, who does need to improve his stick.

SA 02/19/21 B- FT 48.0 HG

ELECTOR (B-) working with STORM SEEKER (B-) - This duo from different barns came out of the gate together, STORM SEEKER inside; The pair broke well, STORM SEEKER 1/2 length in front in 12.3, 23.4, 35.2, neither asked, STORM SEEKER was still 1/2 length in front when up in 47.4, appearing a bit best, certainly decent. ELECTOR was 1/2 length back in 47.4, then continued solo to the 1/8 pole, lightly urged in 100.3, an ok work.

SA 02/11/21 C+ FT 103.0 H

STORM SEEKER went much faster than given, but did not look good doing it in this five furlong drill, splits of 12.1, 24.0, passing the 1/4 pole in 36.2, he switched to his wrong lead past midstretch, asked to the wire in 101.4, much faster than given, but not a very good work

STORM SEEKER worked for The Vet in this five furlong drill, opening 3/8 in 37.3, hard urged while tiring in 103.0, not a good work

SA 01/03/21 C+ FT 49.4 H

STORM SEEKER was doing his best in this half-mile work, urged along through even splits of 24.4 for a 49.3 final time, not overly impressive.

LUCK IS GOLDEN

SA 02/20/21 B FT 100.3 H

LUCK IS GOLDEN (B) working with TIZ PLUS (B-) - This team went together from the 5/8 pole, we had the final 3/8 of the work, TIZ PLUS inside; The pair passed the 1/4 pole in 12.0, LUCK IS GOLDEN was under a big hold, appearing best in 36.1, galloping out down to the 7/8 pole in 49.1, a good work for the comebacker, who has been gelded off the layoff and appears much improved off the bench. TIZ PLUS was hand ridden to stay together, second best, a decent work

SA 02/13/21 B- FT 101.2 H

LUCK IS GOLDEN (B-) working with TIZ PLUS (B-) - This team went together from the 5/8 pole, TIZ PLUS wearing blinkers starting two lengths in front; The pair maintained their positions, crawling along early in 13.2, 25.2, passing the 1/4 pole in 37.4, LUCK IS GOLDEN was lightly urged, unable to get by his workmate while plastered with dirt, 1/2 length back at the wire in 101.4, TIZ PLUS hand ridden, 1/2 lengths in front in 102.1, TIZ PLUS opened back up on the gallop out down to the 7/8 pole in 115.0, LUCK IS GOLDEN falling back in 115.4, a decent work for both.

SA 02/05/21 B FT 100.4 H

LUCK IS GOLDEN looked good in this comeback five furlong work, splits of 12.1, 24.3, passing the 1/4 pole in 37.0, switching leads perfectly (sometimes he doesn't), not asked, finishing well, final time of 100.4, galloping out down to the 7/8 pole in 114.1, a good work for the comebacker Cal-bred, who should be seen fairly soon

SA 01/28/21 C+ FT 101.1 HG

LUCK IS GOLDEN came out of the gate solo, breaking slowly, splits of 13.1, 24.4, 36.4, 48.4, very late switching leads, lightly asked in 101.1, just ok this week, the comebacker needs to break better and switch leads in a timelier manner

SA 01/21/21 B- FT 101.0 H

LUCK IS GOLDEN wore blinkers for this five furlong comeback work, fractions of 24.3, passing the 1/4 pole in 36.4, lightly niggled to the wire in 101.0, a decent work.

SA 01/14/21 B- FT 102.0 H

LUCK IS GOLDEN went easily in this five furlong move, not asked in 101.4, a decent work.

LUCK IS GOLDEN

SA 01/07/21 B- FT NTG H

LUCK IS GOLDEN did not make the original worksheet, but we had him going a half-mile, final time of 48.3, not asked at all, a decent work for the comebacker, who is a month or two away from returning.

SA 12/31/20 B- FT 48.3 H

LUCK IS GOLDEN went rather nicely in this half-mile move, going off in 12.2, 24.2, picking it up well crossing midstretch in 36.0, not asked a drop to the wire in 48.3, galloping out with verve own to the 7/8 pole in 102.0, a decent work for sure.

SA 02/15/21 B- FT 101.1 H

CANADIAN PRIDE (B-) working with LIL RICHARDS BELLO (B-) - This team went five furlongs from the 1/2 mile pole, CANADIAN PRIDE inside; The pair went off in 12.1, 24.1, crossing with in 48.1, not asked down to the 7/8 pole in 101.1, a decent work for both

SA 02/08/21 B- FT 59.4 H

LIL RICHARDS BELLO (B-) working with SUGAR PICKEL (C+) - This team went five furlongs from the 3/8 pole, we picked them up at the 1/4 pole, together at that point; The pair crossed the wire in 23.3, LIL RICHARDS BELLO was not asked down to the 7/8 pole, appearing best in 36.2, a decent work. SUGAR PICKEL was urged to keep up, second best, a so-so work. We cannot verify the Official Clocking's or the difference in times.

LIL RICHARDS BELLO (B) working with YOU'RE ALL TALK (B-) - This team went together from the 1/2 mile pole, LIL RICHARDS BELLO inside; The pair went off in 23.3, LIL RICHARDS BELLO was lightly urged, pulling clear in 47.1, a good work for the trial Cal-bred maiden. YOU'RE ALL TALK was urged, falling back in 47.2, an ok work.

LIL RICHARDS BELLO (B) working with DREAM SHAKE (B-) - This team went together from the 1/2 mile pole, LIL RICHARDS BELLO, wearing blinkers, starting 1 1/2 lengths in front; DREAM SHAKE made up ground right away to get close in 12.0, 23.4, LIL RICHARDS BELLO in 12.1, 24.0, LIL RICHARDS BELLO edged a length clear again crossing midstretch in 36.0 for both, LIL RICHARDS BELLO was going easily late, finishing 1/2 length in front, receiving the slower time of 48.0, then galloping out a length in front down to the 7/8 pole in 100.0, best of the duo, a good, improved work. DREAM SHAKE was lightly urged to get within 1/2 length at the wire in 47.4, falling a length back again on the gallop out in 100.0, a decent work, but a bit second best this week.

SA 02/19/21 B- FT 49.2 H

SCARY FAST SMILE finished well in this half-mile move, opening 1/4 in 25.1, not asked in 49.1, final 1/4 in 24.0, a decent work

SA 02/12/21 B- FT 101.3 H

SCARY FAST SMILE went five furlongs from the 1/2 mile pole, passing the 1/4 pole in 24.4. not asked to the wire in 49.0, going easily down to the 7/8 pole in 101.3, a decent work.

SA 02/01/21 B- FT 59.1 H

PHAROAH'S HEART (B+), SCARY FAST SMILE (B), CLOSING REMARKS (B-) and VRONSKY ZIPS AWAY (C+) working together - This quartet from different barns hooked in together from the 5/8 pole,

VRONSKY ZIPS AWAY starting a length in front of CLOSING REMARKS, five lengths in front of SCARY FAST SMILE, who wore blinkers and had T. Baze up and eight lengths in front of PHAROAH'S HEART; SCARY FAST SMILE and PHAROAH'S HEART maintained their positions making up three lengths early in 12.1, CLOSING REMARKS and VRONSKY ZIPS AWAY in 12.4, SCARY FAST SMILE came through inside of the top pair to together in 23.4, PHAROAH'S HEART still three back of him in 23.4, CLOSING REMARKS getting even with his workmate in 24.3, VRONSKY ZIPS AWAY in 24.4, SCARY FAST SMILE was 3/4 length back passing the 1/4 pole in 35.2, PHAROAH'S HEART two lengths back in 35.1, CLOSING REMARKS 36.1, VRONSKY ZIPS AWAY in 36.2, the two leaders came off the rail, allowing the Glatt horses plenty of room, PHAROAH'S HEART split horses and was never asked, doing best late, finishing evenly with her workmate in 58.3, SCARY FAST SMILE not asked a lot in 59.1, galloping out far in front, a very sharp work for PHAROAH'S HEART who looks ready for another smasher, good for SCARY FAST SMILE. The Gaines pair did not keep up, CLOSING REMARKS not asked in 100.4, a decent work, VRONSKY ZIPS AWAY lightly asked in 10.1, just ok for her.

DESERVEDLY (B-) working with SCARY FAST SMILE (B-) - This team went together over a dull main track, DESERVEDLY inside; The pair were never asked, together in 100.2, a decent work for both.

SCARY FAST SMILE went easily in this half-mile maintenance spin, opening 1/4 in 25.0, never asked in 50.1, just a leg stretcher

SUNSHINE BABE went off from the 1/2 mile pole, splits of 11.4, 24.0, crossing midstretch, in 36.1, lightly urged to the wire in 48.1, galloping out down to the 7/8 pole in 101.2, an ok work, better than usual for her low percentage barn

SUNSHINE BABE went a half-mile from the 3/8 pole, passing the 1/4 pole in 12.3, lightly asked crossing the wire in 37.1, continuing under light urging down to the 7/8 pole in 49.4, a so-so work, typical of most horses from this barn

SA 01/27/21 C+ FT 37.3 H

SUNSHINE BABE looked so-so over the training track, going off in 12.4, niggled a bit in the stretch, final time of 37.4, just ok

Prior to Last Race -----**SHOUT IT OUT****SA 01/31/21 M FT 50.2 H**

SHOUT IT OUT had T. Baze up for this half-mile maintenance spin, not asked in 50.2, final furlong in 12.2, just a leg stretcher

SA 01/17/21 C+ FT 102.2 H

SHOUT IT OUT went off from the 5/8 pole with T. Baze up, fractions of 12.1, 24.3, passing the 1/4 pole in 37.1, lightly urged and tapped in the stretch, slowing to the wire in 102.2, galloping out down to the 7/8 pole in 116.4, a so-so work.

SA 01/11/21 M FT 104.1 H

SHOUT IT OUT went easily in this five furlong maintenance spin, we had the final 1/4 of this work in 25.1, never asked at all, just a leg stretcher. We cannot verify the Official Time.

Prior to Last Race -----**WINTER STAR****SA 02/05/21 C+ FT 48.2 HG**

KINGS TABLE (C+) working with WINTER STAR (C+) - This team wore blinkers for their gate work, WINTER STAR inside; KINGS TABLE was quicker early, leading in 12.4, WINTER STAR in 13.0, they got together in 24.4, then chased a separate working Kruljac trainee in 36.3, WINTER STAR was tapped a bit coming to the 1/4 pole in 49.2, WINTER STAR up there, KINGS TABLE was urged and tapped to midstretch, WINTER STAR galloping out on even terms in 103.0, neither very impressive and both went much slower than given, KINGS TABLE further than given.

SA 01/28/21 B- FT 48.3 H

DONNA BELLA (B), CROSS INDIAN (B-) and WINTER STAR (B-) working together - This trio from different barns hooked in together, DONNA BELLA wearing blinkers breaking off from the 5/8 pole, opening furlong in 12.0, she was two lengths behind the duo of CROSS INDIAN, who was inside of WINTER STAR, both wearing blinkers as they went off from the 1/2 mile pole; The threesome got together quickly, DONNA BELLA in 23.1 (a quick 11.1 middle furlong), 35.2, CROSS INDIAN and WINTER STAR in 11.3, 23.4, DONNA BELLA was a best late, niggled the final strides, finishing a neck back inside in 100.1, falling back on the gallop out in 114.0, still a good work. WINTER STAR was tapped into the stretch, then both horses were asked, CROSS INDIAN asked more, finishing a neck in front between horses in 48.3, galloping out in front down to the 7/8 pole in 101.3, decent for them despite the urging.

WARRENS CANDY GIRL**SA 02/07/21 B- FT 50.2 H**

WARRENS CANDY GIRL finished well in this half-mile move, going off in 13.1, 26.1, not asked, finishing up in 50.2, not a bad work, better than the time would indicate.

SA 01/28/21 B FT 48.0 H

WARRENS CANDY GIRL (B) working with WARRENS CANDY MAN (B-) - This team went together from the 1/2 mile pole, WARRENS CANDY GIRL inside; The pair went off in 24.0, WARRENS CANDY GIRL not asked, pulling a length clear in 48.0, a good work. WARRENS CANDY MAN was lightly asked, falling a length back in 48.1, ok for him.

WARREN'S CANDY GIRL finished well in this faster than given half-mile work, wearing blinkers, splits of 12.1, 24.1, lightly urged and receiving one left handed whip nearing midstretch in 36.0, asked to finish, but responding in 47.3, final furlong in 11.3, final 1/4 in 23.2, galloping out down to the 7/8 pole in 100.2, a good work.

AGATA (B-) working with ALMOST A FACTOR (B-) - This team went together from the 1/2 mile pole, AGATA inside; The pair went off in 24.3, not asked in 49.2, a decent enough move for both

SA 01/21/21 B- FT 50.0 H

AGATA (B-) working with MONGOLIAN FORD (C) - This duo from different barns hooked in together, AGATA starting two lengths in front; The pair maintained their positions in 25.4, AGATA was lightly urged, increasing her advantage in 50.0, final 1/4 in 24.1, an ok work. MONGOLIAN FORD was urged, dropping further back in 50.2, not good at all.

OLD INDIAN TRICK went a half-mile over the training track, we had the final 3/8 in 12.0 niggled a bit in the stretch, up in 36.2, a decent work. We cannot verify the Official time

OLD INDIAN TRICK went a half-mile over the training track, we had the final 3/8 of the work in 12.1, niggled along, finishing up well in 36.2, a decent work.

OLD INDIAN TRICK SA 01/27/21 B- FT 35.4 H

OLD INDIAN TRICK went three furlongs over the training track, passing the 1/4 pole in 12.2, lightly urged, but responding, final time of 36.1, final 1/4 in 23.4, a decent work for the veteran gelding, who needed his comeback race and should do better with that race under his belt against restricted claimers

OLD INDIAN TRICK went a half-mile over the training track, going off in 13.0, 25.0, hand ridden to deep stretch then urged to the wire, showing some response in 49.3, an ok work, but really made to do it.

REBEL WAR SA 02/19/21 B- FT 100.0 H

REBEL WAR went off from the 5/8 pole, opening 3/8 in 35.4, lightly niggled, finishing with something left in 100.0, better than most horses from this barn. He has been gelded off the long layoff.

SA 02/14/21 M FT 104.4 H

REBEL WAR was not asked in this early a.m. five furlong maintenance spin, moving slowly throughout in 104.4, final furlong in 13.0, just a leg stretcher

SA 02/04/21 B- FT 102.1 H

REBEL WAR wore an outside-extension blinker for this five furlong work, going off easily in 12.3, 24.4, passing the 1/4 pole in 37.1, not asked at all in the stretch, up at the wire in 102.0, galloping out down to the 7/8 pole in 115.2, not a bad work for his low percentage trainer.

REBEL WAR worked early in the a.m., opening 1/4 in 24.2, lightly asked in 49.0, just ok this week.

SA 01/07/21 B- FT 48.3 H

REBEL WAR looked ok this week, opening 1/4 in 24.1. not asked in 48.3, not a bad work

SA 12/30/20 C+ FT 48.1 H

REBEL WAR worked early in the a.m., opening 1/4 in 24.0, pushed along in the stretch, doing his best to the wire, final time of 48.1, just ok as he was doing his best

5th Race 6 Furlongs Dirt**LETSGETLUCKY**

SA 02/22/21 B+ FT 38.4 H

LETSGETLUCKY went much, much, much faster on our watch than he the Official Clockers got, going off in 11.4, speeding up in the stretch, crossing midstretch, 22.4, niggled to the wire in 34.0, a tremendous display of speed from the unraced Cal-bred Munnings colt, who appears a quick sort and should be very tough at first asking

SA 02/12/21 B FT 100.2 H

EEL POINT (B) working with LETSGETLUCKY (B) - This duo from different barns went together for the 5/8 pole, LETSGETLUCKY inside; We had the final 1/4 of this work in 23.2, neither asked, both looking good to the wire. We cannot verify the Official Time, but we like what we saw here.

SA 02/05/21 B FT 47.4 H

LETSGETLUCKY (B) working with FURSACE (B-) - This team went together from the 1/2 mile pole, LETSGETLUCKY Inside; The pair went off in 24.0, LETSGETLUCKY was not asked, pulling a length clear in 47.4, a good work. FURSACE was lightly urged, second best, in 48.0, ok

SA 01/15/21 B- FT 102.0 HG

LETSGETLUCKY (B-) working with FERRARIANO (C) - This team of Kentucky sired, California bred three-year-olds came out of the gate together, LETSGETLUCKY inside; FERRARIANO broke fine to open up in 13.0, LETSGETLUCKY broke very slowly, well back in 14.0, LETSGETLUCKY rushed up along the rail to get even in 25.2, 37.1, then LETSGETLUCKY edged a length clear coming to the 1/4 pole in 49.2, FERRARIANO in 49.3, LETSGETLUCKY pulled clear, never asked in 102.0, a decent work considering the break, which we will need to improve. FERRARIANO was urged, falling two lengths back in 102.2, not impressive.

FERRARIANO (B-) working with LETSGETLUCKY (B-) - This team went together from the 5/8 pole, we had the final 1/4 of this work, together when we picked them up, final 1/4 in 25.0, a decent work. The Official Clockers separated them, we didn't see them break off.
