

ON THIS DATE (1989) – On June 17, 1989, a talented field faced off in the La Crosse. **PENTELICUS** (G2 placed a few starts later) won the 6F stakes in 1:09.1 over Supreme Explosion (claimer of the '88 meet) and Joel (beat the legendary Who Doctor Who in '88). Favored Swingin Sway was a 6-time stakes winner of 400k. He won a G3 at Ak-Sar-Ben 2 starts later.

Canterbury dirt favors those who with speed. This one will be coming from dead last. But the speed might duel and set it up for her. She's been 1st or 2nd in 8 of her last 10. 5th beaten 11 in the last start (You Got This) won back in same race Strong Patriot was third.

VALUE: 3 CHEVERIE

Those shipping from the Nebraska circuit (Fonner & Horseman's Park) haven't performed well here thus far. But this one has been sharp in 5 starts this year and fits in nicely in this spot. 9YO mare been in the exacta 14 of 35 on dry dirt. Use in the exotic wagers.

Upset winner of the 2019 Northbound Pride stakes at this distance. Nibbled since then until she won in her last start at TUP. The best races for this 5YO mare came for Van Winkle who is off to a nice start so far at this meet. She'll track quietly while saving ground.

VALUE: 2 LADY ORCHID

Oklahoma invader has 3 straight wins down south at RP and WRD. She has done nothing but fire in every start for Bravo (8 wins). Showed she can handle the distance with wins in the More Than Even in the last two years at 1M 1/16. Gets one of the top riders here.

Arizona-based trainer Cappellucci is having a strong meet, his first in Shakopee. This one transfers from Jonathan Wong in No California. There's a chance he will control the pace. Last win was at Del Mar about 10 months ago at 8-1 wire to wire. Will get a soft trip.

VALUE: 3 FLIP THE COIN JAN

Moved barns and shipped in from So California and upset a small field at 7-1. The runner-up didn't get a good break and was behind the field. He won back in opt clm 10k last Wed at 4-5. He did have 4 wins in So Cal and has a bit of backclass. Might be stubborn.

Tried the turf going long in the debut. That isn't that surprising as there is a deep turf female family here for Mike Biehler. He didn't do much in that start but that was a loaded race (2nd, 3rd were running well in open MSW at FG and KEE). Biehler 18% with 2nd timers.

VALUE: 7 PASSTHECAT

Of the five races he's run, his two worst efforts were on off-tracks. He was coming off the layoff and drew the 12 post in last. Sire ran 3rd in the 2013 Kentucky Derby and won the 2014 Pimlico Special at 1M 3/16. Good run for third at 58-1 in stakes 3 back. Improves.

Won 3 of 4 here last summer and one of those was a turf win at 8-1 at this distance. Came off the layoff 2 back and drew t4eh widest 11 post. She ran well for third in a common race that some of these were in. Faced better in her last start. Reasonable class drop.

VALUE: 5 INDAWIN

Claimed out of her last start when she set the pace in a similar spot and faded to third at 5-2 odds. She has the blinkers removed as they'll have her relax a bit more today. Her three wins all came from a spot just behind the speed. The leading rider gets aboard.

Trainer Karl Broberg has won 48% (76 of 158) with a last out claim who won race in which it was claimed out of and off at 2-1 or less. That same angle here at Canterbury produced 7 of 7 in the exacta (two wins). Repeat of last should be enough to get the job done.

VALUE: 8 SIOUX VALLEY

He is talented enough to compete in here but don't know if he'll be cranked up off the layoff. Trainer is 5 for 19 in the money (1 win) off long layoffs similar to this. Beat the top choice two back at 8-1. Very sharp works, well-spaced drills into this. Regular rider up.

PICK: 4 LUVIN BULLIES 9YO mare started her career (at Canterbury Park) in 2014. She's 7 of 9 in the money on the turf here and 7 for 27 wins on the turf at this distance. Top 4 from her last start all came back to run in the exacta next out. Show finisher won an op clm 80k at CD, 89 Beyer. VALUE: 2 HARKING 6-time winner in just 14 starts and she's been in the money 11 of 14 overall. She's never been on the turf but her sire is a decent turf influencer. Favored last out in the race won by Arizona Star. She was burned up in a pace duel. Dangerous if she handles the turf. A) 1,2,4 B) 3,5 C) 6		PICK: 4 SHAKELAS DESTINY The word was out on the winner of his last race. The winner was a second time starter who was bet to a 7-5 favorite, won by 6 and was claimed. This one had trip trouble in both of his last two starts. Beat a few in here in the first couple of starts. Top rider is back. VALUE: 3 CAUSEIMCHOCOLATE Only been on fast dirt once and that was vs stakes 3 back. Clearly didn't love the off-going in last. He ran last beaten 22 lengths at 7-1. Trainer starting to get hot (won 9 of last 36 here). Expecting improvement if the track is dry. Good to see Hamilton back aboard. A) 2,4,7 B) 3,5 C)
