SA 02/22/21 B- FT 100.2 H

SIGALERT looked ok in this five furlong work, opening 3/8 in 36.0, lightly urged in 100.2, not a terrible work

SA 02/15/21 B- FT 101.1 H

SIGALERT (B-) working with HALLOWED GIFT (C+) - This team went together from the 5/8 pole, SIGALERT inside; The pair went off quickly, splits of 12.0, 23.3, passing the 1/4 pole in 35.3, SIGALERT was going easier late, very lightly niggled to the wire in 101.1, an ok work. HALLOWED GIFT was hand ridden, second best, just ok for the low level type

SA 02/08/21 B- FT 102.0 H

M TOWN GEM (B-), SIGALERT (B-) and RIP CITY (C+) working together - This trio hooked in together from the 5/8 pole, RIP CITY wearing blinkers inside, M TOWN GEM in the middle with SIGALERT starting one length in front on the outside; All three were together passing the 1/4 pole in 37.1 for M TOWN GEM and RIP CITY, 37.2 for SIGALERT, M TOWN GEM and SIGALERT were going easily late, final times of 101.0 for M TOWN GEM, 101.1 for SIGALERT, final 1/4 in 23.4, a decent work for them. RIP CITY was urged inside, third best in 101.0, a so-so work for the sharp gelding, who didn't look as good here.

SIGALERT looked decent in this half-mile move, opening 1/4 in 24.0, not asked in 48.2, not bad at all.

#### EXULTATION

EXULTATION went easily in this half-mile maintenance spin, never asked in 50.0, just a leg stretcher

SA 02/14/21 B FT 47.2 H

EXULTATION went well in this half-mile move, opening 1/4 in 23.3 not asked at all in 47.2, a good work.

SA 02/07/21 B- FT 48.2 H

EXULTATION (B-) working with WARBIRD (C+) - This team went together from the 1/2 mile pole, WARBIRD starting two lengths in front; EXULTATION made up a length passing the 1/4 pole in 24.1, WARBIRD in 24.2, EXULTATION was niggled, getting even at the wire, up in 48.2, a decent work. WARBIRD was hand ridden in 48.4, continuing solo down to the 7/8 pole, displaying a high, turfy action, up in 101.2, slower than given, displaying a high action as if grass would be better.

EKKLESIA (B-) working with EXULTATION (B-) - This team went together from the 1/2 mile pole, EXULTATION inside; The pair went off in 24.1, neither asked at all in 48.3, a decent work for both.

EXULTATION went much faster than given in this five furlong move, splits of 12.2, 24.4, passing the 1/4 pole in 36.3, not asked much in 100.2, galloping out down to the 7/8 pole in 113.3, a decent work.

We cannot verify the Official time.

HOT ROD CHARLIE (B-) working with SQUALOTORO (B-) - This team went six furlongs together from the 5/8 pole, SQUALOTORO starting 3/4 length in front of HOT ROD CHARLIE, who wore blinkers; The pair maintained their positions in 12.3, 25.1, together passing the 1/4 pole in 37.3, HOT ROD CHARLIE was not asked a drop in the stretch, SQUALOTORO very lightly niggled, crossing the wire in 102.1, they continued down to the 7/8 pole, up there in 114.3, going a full six furlongs, then both horses galloped out down to the 7/8 pole in 128.4, a decent work for both

SHUSTER (B-) working with ZIP DE VILLE (B-) - This team went together in this five furlong work, going off from the 1/2 mile pole, passing the 1/4 pole in 25.1, crossing the wire in 50.0, lightly niggled down to the 7/8 pole in 102.3, an ok work for both

REDEMPTION CODE (C+) working with SHUSTER (C-) - This duo from different barns hooked in together, REDEMPTION CODE breaking off from the 5/8 pole starting five lengths back; REDEMPTION CODE made up a length early in 12.4, SHUSTER in 13.0, REDEMPTION CODE made up two more lengths in 25.1, SHUSTER in 25.4, REDEMPTION CODE came through inside around the far turn to get even in 37.1, SHUSTER in 38.1, REDEMPTION CODE was lightly urged in the stretch, drawing well clear in 102.3, galloping out down to the 7/8 pole in 117.0, a so-so work. SHUSTER no match in 104.2, a poor drill.

GALLOPING MISCHIEF looked fine in this half-mile training track work, going off in 12.3, 24.2, lightly asked in deep stretch, finishing up in 49.3, an ok work

SA 01/17/21 M FT 50.0 H

GALLOPING MISCHIEF went much, much slower than given in this half-mile maintenance spin, crawling from the pole, fractions of 14.2, 27.1, not asked in 51.4, just a leg stretcher. Not sure where the Official Clockers got this time from?

CAPTURE THE SEA (B-) working with GALLOPING MISCHIEF (B-) - This duo from different barns hooked in together over the training track, GALLOPING MISCHIEF going off from the 5/8 pole, opening furlong in 12.0, he was two lengths in front of CAPTURE THE SEA, who went off from the 1/2 mile pole, The pair maintained their positions, GALLOPING MISCHIEF in 24.2, 36.3, CAPTURE THE SEA in 12.2, 24.3, the pair got even in the stretch, neither asked, 101.0 for GALLOPING MISCHIEF, 48.3 for CAPTURE THE SEA, decent for both

GALLOPING MISCHIEF went five furlongs over the training track, fractions of 24.2, 36.3, reaching to the wire while not asked in 101.2, a decent work.

ROYAL SHIP (B-) working with AMERICAN DANCER (C) - This duo from different barns hooked in together, we picked ROYAL SHIP up just past the 1/2 mile pole, four lengths behind AMERICAN DANCER, who wore a Figure 8; The pair maintained their positions in 11.4, 23.3, ROYAL SHIP cut through alongside AMERICAN DANCER in the stretch, going on by late, a length in front crossing the wire in 35.3, AMERICAN DANCER fairly hard urged, getting outrun in 36.3, up there, not impressive. ROYAL SHIP continued to be asked down to the 7/8 pole in 48.2, up there, a decent work, but made to do it. We cannot verify the Official Times, but both seem way too fast.

AMERICAN DANCER (B-) working with BEER CAN MAN (B-) - This team went together from the 1/2 mile pole, AMERICAN DANCER wearing a Figure 8 inside; BEER CAN MAN was 1/2 length in front early in 12.1, passing the 1/4 pole in 24.1, they got together into the stretch, slowing crossing midstretch in 37.1, AMERICAN DANCER was just in front to the wire in 49.4, galloping out a length in front in 102.2, BEER CAN MAN in 102.3, a decent work for both. AMERICAN DANCER is a New Mexico invader who should be close to making his local debut, BEER CAN MAN should be seen in a three-year-old grass stakes

SA 01/18/21 B- FT 47.3 H  
AMERICAN DANCER went easily in this half-mile move, even splits of 23.4 for a 47.3 final time lightly niggled late, a decent work.

SA 01/11/21 B- FT 113.0 H  
AMERICAN DANCER (B-), MOTOWN MUSIC (B-) and OUR MISS MILLIE (C+) working together - This trio from different barns hooked in together, AMERICAN DANCER and MOTOWN MUSIC breaking off from the 3/4 pole, AMERICAN DANCER inside; The pair went off in 12.3, they were joined three-wide by OUR MISS MILLIE at the 5/8 pole, AMERICAN MUSIC and MOTOWN MUSIC pulled a length clear in 36.1, 48.1, OUR MISS MILLIE in 23.4, 35.4, AMERICAN DANCER and MOTOWN MUSIC were lightly urged, remaining a length in front at the wire in 113.0, a decent work for both. OUR MISS MILLIE was urged, unable to get back together in 100.3, just ok this week.

**STONE'S RIVER** SA 02/19/21 B- FT 102.1 H  
STONE'S RIVER went easily in this early a.m. five furlong move, opening 3/8 in 37.0, not asked at all in 102.0, a decent work.

SA 02/11/21 B- FT 101.1 H  
STONE'S RIVER (B-) working with GONE QUICK (C+) - This duo from different barns hooked in together, STONE'S RIVER breaking off from the 5/8 pole, opening furlong in 12.3, he was two lengths in front of GONE QUICK as that one went off from the 1/2 mile pole; GONE QUICK made up a length early in 11.4, STONE'S RIVER in 24.3, they were together passing the 1/4 pole, STONE'S RIVER in 36.4, GONE QUICK in 23.4, STONE'S RIVER pulled clear again in the stretch, lightly urged late to finish the same two lengths in front he started at the wire in 101.3, galloping out down to the 7/8 pole in 115.3, a decent work. GONE QUICK was urged, giving ground in 49.0, galloping out down to the 7/8 pole in 103.0, a so-so work.

BIG WELL (C+) working with REFUSE (C+) - This team went five furlongs together, we had the final 1/4 of this work in 24.1, both lightly urged, but not looking all that great late, just ok. We cannot verify the Official Times.

MARCKIE'S WATER (B) working with BIG WELL (B-) - This team went together from the 5/8 pole, BIG WELL inside of MARCKIE'S WATER, who wore blinkers; The pair went off in 12.1, 24.1, passing the 1/4 pole in 35.4, MARCKIE'S WATER was not asked a drop, up at the wire in 100.2, BIG WELL was niggled along, receiving one whip to finish together, then was lightly asked on the gallop out to get a length in front down to the 7/8 pole in 114.0, MARCKIE'S WATER in 114.1, a good work for him, decent, but second best for BIG WELL.

BIG WELL (C+) working with OSCAR NOD (C+) - This team went together in this five furlong work, opening 1/4 in 24.4, passing the 1/4 pole in 37.1, both horses were lightly urged, not giving all that much of a response in 102.2, a so-so work for both.

**BIG WELL** SA 01/28/21 B- FT 101.2 H  
BIG WELL (B-) working with SILVER MOON ROAD (B-) - This team went together from the 5/8 pole, SILVER MOON ROAD inside; The pair went off in 12.2, 24.3, passing the 1/4 pole in 36.2, neither horse asked much in the stretch, up at the wire in 101.2 galloping out down to the 7/8 pole in 115.0, a decent work for both.

BIG TALKER (B-) working with BIG WELL (B-) - This team went together from the 1/2 mile pole, BIG WELL starting a length in front; BIG TALKER got even passing the 1/4 pole in 24.2, BIG WELL in 24.3, BIG TALKER was a bit best, never asked in 49.0, a decent work. BIG WELL was lightly niggled in 49.1, ok enough.

FUNKENSTEIN looked absolutely awful in this slow five furlong drill, going off in 12.4, 25.0, tapped a couple of times nearing the 1/4 pole in 37.1, ears pinned in the stretch, not seeming happy at all, ridden along in 104.2, final 1/4 in 27.1, a terrible drill.

FUNKENSTEIN (C+) working with RACKATAPTAP (C+) - This team went together in this five furlong work, FUNKENSTEIN was carried a bit wide into the stretch, appearing a bit best in 101.3, RACKATAPTAP in 101.4, a so-so work for both

SA 02/05/21 C+ FT 102.2 H  
RACKATAPTAP (B-) working with FUNKENSTEIN (C+) - This team went together from the 5/8 pole, FUNKENSTEIN starting one length in front; RACKATAPTAP got even in the stretch, final time of 102.1, a decent work. FUNKENSTEIN was niggled in 102.2, just ok this week.

MINEHUNTER (C+) working with FUNKENSTEIN (C+) - This team came out of the gate together, FUNKENSTEIN inside; The pair broke fine, neither quick in 13.0, 24.4, 36.4, neither asked, MINEHUNTER a bit best in 49.2, showing a very turfy action, both galloping out to 1/8 pole in 102.4, just ok for both.

**SWEETEST ANGEL** SA 02/20/21 C+ FT 102.2 H  
SWEETEST ANGEL was asked along in this five furlong drill, not showing a lot of response in 102.2, a so-so work, but this filly has run better than she has trained of late, so this may not mean much

**SWEETEST ANGEL** SA 02/01/21 C+ FT 104.2 H  
SWEETEST ANGEL looked so-so this week, fractions of 25.4, 38.3, lightly asked in 104.2, slowing late, not overly impressive, the maiden filly appears to be going the wrong way

SA 01/22/21 C+ FT 102.4 H  
SWEETEST ANGEL (C+) working SHERILINDA (C) - This team went together from the 5/8 pole over a dull main track, we picked them up at the 1/4 pole, SHERILINDA inside with T. Baze up; SWEETEST ANGEL was hand ridden in the stretch, getting in front in 25.2, a so-so work. SHERILINDA was struggling late, falling back in 25.3, not hard asked, but not impressive. We cannot verify the Official times

**JIBBER JABBER (IRE)** SA 02/20/21 C FT 49.4 H  
JIBBER JABBER wore earmuffs for this very modest half-mile work, splits of 12.2, passing the 1/4 pole in 24.2, crossing midstretch in 36.4, niggled the final furlong, slowing in 49.4, not impressive



**JIBBER JABBER (IRE)** SA 02/08/21 C+ FT 103.1 H  
BESTRELLA (B-) working with JIBBER JABBER (C+) -  
This team went together from the 5/8 pole, we picked them up at the 4 1/2 furlong marker, JIBBER JABBER three lengths up there, BESTRELLA made up a length by the time we started clocking from the 1/2 mile pole, BESTRELLA was one length back at the 3/8 pole in 12.2, JIBBER JABBER in 12.3, they were together passing the 1/4 pole in 24.3 for BESTRELLA, 25.0 for JIBBER JABBER, BESTRELLA was best in the stretch, not asked much, getting a head in front at the wire in 49.2, galloping out down to the 7/8 pole in 103.2, an ok work. JIBBER JABBER received a whip, lightly urged in 49.4, galloping out down to the 7/8 pole in 103.4, just ok. We did not see them break off, so we cannot verify the Official Times or how far in front JIBBER JABBER actually broke off.

STAR OF AFRICA (B-) working with JIBBER JABBER (C+) - This team went together from the 1/2 mile pole, STAR OF AFRICA starting two lengths in front; The pair maintained their positions in 13.1, JIBBER JABBER was 1/2 length back passing the 1/4 pole in 26.0, STAR OF AFRICA in 26.2, they were together near midstretch, then STAR OF AFRICA edged a length clear late, not asked, receiving the slower time of 51.2, but best, a decent work. JIBBER JABBER gave ground late in 51.1, just ok. We are not sure why the Official Clockers gave them the same time?

**SHVERE ARBETER** SA 02/19/21 C+ FT 50.1 H  
SHVERE ARBETER did not look as good as usual in this early a.m. half-mile work, opening 1/4 in 25.1, lightly urged, never really picking it up, final time of 50.1, a so-so work for the usually good workhorse

**SHVERE ARBETER** SA 01/27/21 B+ FT 47.2 H  
SHVERE ARBETER looked really good over the training track not asked a drop in 47.2, gliding over the surface, a really nice work this week, perhaps this one is ready to fire a big shot.

SHVERE ARBITER finished well in this half-mile work, opening 1/4 in 24.1. lightly pressured, but responding in 47.4, final 1/4 in 23.3. certainly decent.

**CIDER APPLE (GB)** SA 02/20/21 B- FT 49.0 H  
CIDER APPLE (B-) working with QUATROELLE (B-) -  
This team went together from the 1/2 mile pole, CIDER APPLE inside of QUATROELLE, who had T. Baze up; The pair went off in 12.2, 24.3, neither asked, QUATROELLE a neck in front in 49.0, a bit best, but decent for both

Prior to Last Race -----

**CIDER APPLE (GB)** SA 01/30/21 B- GD 49.4 H  
CIDER APPLE (B-) working with K P KAN DO (B-) -  
This team went together from the 1/2 mile pole over a "good" main track, K P KAN DO on the outside starting 1 1/2 lengths in front of CIDER APPLE, who was 1 1/2 lengths back inside with T. Baze up; CIDER APPLE got within 1/2 length early in 12.3, K P KAN DO in 12.4, they got back to how they started passing the 1/4 pole in 25.1, neither horse was asked in the stretch, CIDER APPLE getting even along the rail in 50.3, K P KAN DO in 50.4, galloping out together down to the 7/8 pole, 103.0 for CIDER APPLE, 103.1 for K P KAN DO, a decent work for both. We have no idea where the Official Clockers came up with these times???

CIDER APPLE (C+) working with SIDEWAY SUANCES (C) - This team went together from the 5/8 pole, SIDEWAY SUANCES starting one length in front; The pair maintained their positions in 12.3, CIDER APPLE was close to his workmate in 24.2, then on even terms passing the 1/4 pole in 37.1, SIDEWAY SUANCES in 24.3, 37.2, CIDER APPLE was not asked, pulling two lengths clear at the wire in a slowing 103.0, SIDEWAY SUANCES lightly urged and hit once in 103.3, then he was lightly asked and hit once on the gallop out down to the 7/8 pole to get back in front in 118.3 for both. So-so work for CIDER APPLE, not impressive for SIDEWAY SUANCES.

CIDER APPLE did not impress in this five furlong work, splits of 12.3, 25.1, getting out noticeably passing the 1/4 pole in 37.4, the rider tapping her many times to try and stay in, hand ridden late in 102.4, galloping out down to the 7/8 pole in 117.0, hard to like this work.

HYLAND HAVEN wore blinkers and went easily in this half-mile move, opening 1/4 in 24.0, not asked in 48.3, an ok work.
