Finished 2 nd with one of those in March with Espinoza at 16-1. Turf pedigree back to 13x turf stakes winner Crystal Moment. VALUE: 3 BIG CHEDDAR Only turf start was a game 9-1 runner-up here with this rider in Jan. The 1 st , 2 nd and 4 th place finishers won next out from that race. Female tree produced major grass influence Cozzene. Will rate slightly here. Moved to the dirt in most recent start and unlucky to lose after a slow start. 2 nd dam a 2x G1 winner on dirt.
