The other two legs were a simulcast of the Michigan Mile won by 28-1 shot Present Value and an allowance won by 7-2 Minor Flaw. The Triple paid \$14,250 for \$2.00.

This first time starter is the only runner who didn't run in the MSW won by 1st timer Pepper Spray. That race didn't appear to be that strong. The works are identical to stablemate Kissalot (in here). Dam is a sib to BC Juv third, Upstart (who won 463k as a 2YO).

VALUE: 2 CAUSE I'M LEAVIN

This gelding had a stream of good works leading up to that common race most of these ran in. He beat just two home but had a faulty start and traveled in a 6-wide path. Was under 3-1 in that race so he may have more to show. Check for any toteboard action.

She's won more races on the turf than anyone else in the race (4 times). Her last win was two back vs. similar at TUP with a solid 81 Beyer. She can finish but in this race she might be right up near the lead without real pace. This rider has been up the last 4.

VALUE: 6 JEN TAKE CHARGE

Sharp wins in back to back starts. She wasn't really forced in either and always looked a winner. Gets a test for class on the jump here but think this outfit has her going in the right direction. Pace might be an issue. Been a looping closer in both local starts.

Trainer Wade Rarick has won with 3 of his last 7 with a first time starter (twice here at CBY). One of those wins was with the sib to this one, Slews Hymn, who crushed by 5 last year. Dam won her debut. Sire is 6 for 19 (31%) w/ a debut 2YO (28% with any first timer).

VALUE: 3 ROLLIN BLACKOUT

This trainer hit the board in all 6 starts this year and 7 of last 8 at CBY. Her only 3 first time 2YO starters ran 3rd at 6-1, 2nd a head at 24-1 (with Goodwin up) and 3rd by less than a length at 25-1. Female line of a 451k earner, Spinoff, who was 2nd in the '19 La Derby.

Ran 5th in a strong allw two back and then he went long in last. Was the 7-5 second choice (winner off as the 6-5 favorite) but tired a bit trying to last the mile distance. Of the 2 in here for Bravo (and both look good) this one looks more honest on the drop.

VALUE: 4 SILVER DASH

He was sent to the lead in the same route race the top choice was third. He hung in strongly finishing 2nd at 5-1. Didn't break well two back but outran 9-1 odds to finish a fast closing third. That was 3rd time he broke poorly from 7 starts. Big win chance here.

Going into Sunday, trainer Diodoro was 1 win back of Mac Robertson for the training lead. This race is full of speed types but this one has closed well in 2 starts here. Winner 2 back won next in allw. Rider 4 wins and 7 in the exacta in the last 8 for R Diodoro.

VALUE: 7 EL TIZAR

This one is bred well and has 3 wins in 5 turf starts. Lone off the board turf effort came in lone start at 1 mile or more. Bred to handle longer and he was getting to the winner at 5F in track record time two back. Butler was up for all 3 of his wins on the turf.

High percentage trainer has teamed up with a high percentage owner for some recent races. This one nibbled vs. some of these in the last few. He'll be a deep closer in here and has only sprinted twice on the dirt in his career. Could be finishing fastest late.

With the rail draw and a very quick work coming in, he'll be sent out front.</p> <p>VALUE: 5 SOME SAY SO 8YO mare has spent 43 of her 52 starts on the grass and racked up 262k in earnings on that surface for this Mn-bred. She was the 2-1 favorite in last in the common race won by flan but weakened late to 3rd there. Front wraps added 2 back. The two off-the-boards were 6-1 and 10-1 so check for betting. Ran well enough in MSW on grass.</p> <p>VALUE: 4 UPTOWN JERSEY GIRL First start since early Jan and another making drop from protected maidens to maiden claiming. Was bet down to 4-1 in last but sloppy start forced him into catch up mode throughout. Two of his sibs were placed in stakes at RP (both for this owner). One to beat here.</p> <p>VALUE: 3 TRESJETDS Ships in from Prairie Meadows where she had just a single start. That came in a futurity trial where she ran a decent 5th at 7-1. Top 3 finishers had run 2nd, 3rd, 1st in different RP maidens prior. Show from last returned to win twice for fun at IND.</p> <p>VALUE: 8 EYEM THE MAN DELFIN It's interesting that this rider (Pinon) rode the rail runner twice including a win in the debut but rides this one (first time for this trainer).
