She grabbed the lead early, opened up on the turn and really looked gone. Then she bore out badly in the lane and was green. Koriner is 4 for last 6 top two comebackers of this type. VALUE: 7 LOVE NOT WAR Only turf sprint resulted in 30-1 placing here two back with Gryder up. Tired last time out going a mile after pressing the fast pace at DMR. Turf pedigree on both sides of the tree. Good clocker reviews. Good runs in MSW two and three back (didn't like the "drifting in"). 3 next out winners out of LRC MSW 3 back. This drop helps. VALUE: 2 ME MACHO Interesting placement. Cost just 3k and could've been in a 20k md clm without risk. Trainer no 1ster wins but top 3 w/ 3 of 5 (all 3 were 18-1 or higher). Clocker reports really liked his Jan 13 th workout. VALUE: 1 BEST TWO MINUTES Ran 2 nd to the top choice in last. It was his first start off a 3 month break and at a track that can be quirky. Trainer does not win much but can be sneaky with a price. He has backclass. Exotics adder. There appears to be a lot of speed in here and could set up nicely for one like her to come from far back. Worked well before, after her most recent start. VALUE: 9 CATOCA She has shown speed in most of her 20 starts but the move to Rispoli will mean she'll rate a bit more here. Doesn't have a turf win but hit the board in 5 of 10 on that surface. He ran 2 nd at 9-2 in a race that is turning out to be strong. 5 th , 6 th , 7 th all came back to take their next starts including Saddle Bar, a winner over a few of these. One to beat. VALUE: 3 RED VALOR Some things changed in his last start, a win at LRC. Front wraps were removed and this apprentice rider was up. He is not very consistent but has a couple of runs putting him in the mix at big odds. Excuses last two (good turf and 45.3 half). Rosario up (he was nosed out on her back in April). VALUE: 6 MS PEINTOUR She'll need a good ride from Blanc. She could be sitting second early off the rail runner and would be dangerous if that one starts to back peddle. Ran 3 rd in a G2 here 8 back. Comes in with 2 bullets. VALUE: 4 JEFFNJOHN'STHUNDR While the public will overvalue the first timers in here, this one has experience edge on some of these. The run 2 back at DMR was good. Winner was a Baffert firster who won 100k stakes at SA next. A) 1,5 B) 2,4,7 C) 3	8th CLM 25K, 1M TURF 33 2 REAL MASTER 6-1 6 TOUGH IT OUT 8-1 1 CABIN JOHN 12-1 3 TEQUILA JOE 7-2 PICK: 2 REAL MASTER Class dropper was steadied in last from the 11 post draw. Added blinkers 2 back but removed immediately. The efforts 3 prior were decent. Massive rider move to Rosario and better inside post today. VALUE: 6 TOUGH IT OUT Pace will be fast and this one should be closing ground. He's a 6x winner on turf out of 19 starts for 230k. Break in races might be helpful to this 7YO gelding.
