ON THIS DATE (1985) – AMELIA BEARHART won one race in her career. It came on August 3, 1985 at Canterbury Downs in a maiden race at 7-1. Her claim to fame would come as a broodmare. She was the dam of the 1997 Champion Turfer Chief Bearhart. He won the Breeders' Cup Turf that year, ended with \$3.2M won and is in the Canadian Hall of Fame.
