

ON THIS DATE (2006) – DONTBOTHERKNOCKING was a decent runner for Steve Asmussen. Once owner Frank Jedlicki moved him to Bernell Rhone, he took off. He would go on to win over \$600k for Rhone (much at Canterbury) over 4 years. On August 6, 2006, he won the John Bullit Stakes for 2nd time. That was his 7th (and final) win at the Minnesota track.
