<p>1 – SANTA ANITA (1:00 PT) CLM 10K, 1M DIRT</p> <p><b>1 Y NOT SIZZLE</b> 3-1  <b>2 YOU WANNA EAR RIP</b> 5-1  <b>7 ODESSA</b> 5-2  <b>9 TIZ WONDERFULLY</b> 6-1</p> <p><b>PICK: 1 Y NOT SIZZLE</b>  <b>VALUE: 2 YOU WANNA EAR RIP</b>          A) 1,2,7 B) 4,9 C) 3,5,6,8</p>	<p>3 – SANTA ANITA (2:12 PT) TOKYO CITY-G3 100K, 1M 1/2 DIRT</p> <p><b>5 ZESTFUL</b> 5-2  <b>3 TIZAMAGICIAN</b> 4-5  <b>4 LURE HIM IN</b> 4-1  <b>2 RONAMO</b> 8-1</p> <p><b>PICK: 5 ZESTFUL</b>          This race will be decided early with how Prat decides to ride Tizamigician. He is a speedy runner but the thinking is he'll let this one get loose and stalk. Former 8k claimer has won 7 of his past 14 and in off a career best. Will try to wire them.</p> <p><b>VALUE: 4 LURE HIM IN</b>          Very dangerous if the top two choices go out with each other. Stumbled slightly at the start of last and was unlucky to lose at 11-1. He's moving from the turf to dirt but is 3 for 4 on the main track. Distance is no issue. Should be finishing well here.</p> <p>A) 3,5 B) 4 C) 1,2</p>	<p>4 – SANTA ANITA (2:45 PT) OPT CLM 40K, 6F TURF</p> <p><b>6 RAKASSAH</b> 3-1  <b>2 JAZZIQUE</b> 5-2  <b>5 LOFTY</b> 3-1  <b>1 NU PI LAMBDA</b> 8-1</p> <p><b>PICK: 6 RAKASSAH</b>          Broke right on top in 3 of her last 4 (got off slowly 3 back). 6<sup>th</sup> in last came back to win at 11-1 vs allw foes next. Winner 2 back won another opt clm next. Clocker reports have her working strongly. She will be tough to reel in if she breaks well.</p> <p><b>VALUE: 1 NU PI LAMBDA</b>          Was right behind the top choice last time out. She was cutting back in distance in there and drew a wide post and was a bit slow early. Smith was up for the maiden win here 5 back. Route speed that cuts back to 6.5F on the dirt from the rail is dangerous. It is interesting that Prat gets up here. He has shown ability but also flopped badly on occasion. Blinkers off (20% for Miller).</p> <p><b>VALUE: 4 BOB'S SNIPER</b>          Pretty impressive win at 9-1 from the 12 post last time out. The last 3 starts when trained by Brinkerhoff have produced all 3 in the exacta. Apparently likes this 6.5F distance. Rider was up for the win in last is back. He's been nibbling vs this class for a few races. Was favored in last but did not break well from the 10 post. Winner 2 back returned to run third by 1-length in a starter at GG. Not facing much here.</p> <p><b>VALUE: 9 STONE'S RIVER</b>          Stumbled at the start in his last race out of the rail draw and was then rushed up into fast fractions and faded. Checked in the start two back. Goes back to Centeno here and gets in light weight. He was up in a career best runner-up at DMR 4 back.</p> <p>A) 2,6,9 B) 3,8 C) 1,4,5,7,10</p>	<p>8 – SANTA ANITA (4:53 PT) KONA GOLD-G3 100K, 6.5F DIRT</p> <p><b>4 BRICKYARD RIDE</b> 3-5  <b>1 CEZANNE</b> 3-1  <b>3 AX MAN</b> 2-1  <b>2 FIGHT ON</b> 20-1</p> <p><b>PICK: 4 BRICKYARD RIDE</b>          Win machine comes into this race off a huge win in the San Carlos. He broke on top and never gave them a chance. That was his first start without Lasix. 6 from the start 2 back returned to either win or run 2<sup>nd</sup>. Wicked early speed from this one.</p> <p><b>VALUE: 1 CEZANNE</b>          There were high expectations for him as a \$3.6M purchase. He won in his first two starts but worked hard at low odds. 4<sup>th</sup> in that 4-horse field in last but didn't run all that badly. Baffert likely sends Ax Man to run w/ the top choice. Should sit the trip.</p> <p>A) 4 B) 1,3 C) 2</p>	<p>9 – SANTA ANITA (5:25 PT) OPT CLM 100K, 6F TURF</p> <p><b>6 EQUILOVE</b> 7-2  <b>3 MISS DRACARYS</b> 7-2  <b>8 MAJESTIC STEPS</b> 3-1  <b>2 ISN'T SHE LOVELY</b> 4-1</p> <p><b>PICK: 6 EQUILOVE</b>          Beat 26 foes in last two starts in Ireland and won here with a strong late rush at 6-5. Outworked the 600k winner (and G2 Elkhorn winner at KEE on Sat) Say the Word in a recent drill. Female line of BC Classic show finisher from 1992 Jolypha.</p> <p><b>VALUE: 3 MISS DRACARYS</b>          Clockers loved her move on 4/8. Was the 9-5 favorite in last but the wide post cost her a better placing. She steadied at the moment she was getting ready to run. L1 today for this expensive filly. <p>6 – SANTA ANITA (3:49 PT) MIZDIRECTION 75K, 6F TURF</p> <p><b>3 CALI BAY</b> 2-1  <b>2 MR. IMPOSSIBLE</b> 5-2  <b>4 ENOUGH NONSENSE</b> 8-1  <b>8 UNCLE ADDOUMA</b> 8-1</p> <p><b>PICK: 3 CALI BAY</b>          Trainer D'Amato has won 6 straight with Euro shippers (all since Nov). 5 of the 6 were in MSW company. 4 winners out of those 6 had Prat up. Beat 10 in the first start on synthetic. Gets L1 here. Sire ran 3rd in the Arc d'Triomphe and won \$2.2M.</p> <p><b>VALUE: 4 ENOUGH NONSENSE</b>          Was 9-2 in the last start but 11 post didn't help his chances and he weakened with a wide trip. Winner two back returned to win an opt clm 100K. 5<sup>th</sup> and 8<sup>th</sup> from that race won next.
