This filly has a long worktab and a superb move on Feb 2 nd . Dam all turf (was stakes placed at GP). VALUE: 13 HAPPY THOUGHT Goes from inside (1 st , 2 nd post in 2 starts) to the widest post today. This could be a big rider move. Think she'll move up in her second start going long. Was the favorite in last. Worked well since then. He was 2 nd by a nose in the 400k Springboard Mile next. Drew widest post on a wet track at CD next going long. Blinkers on here. VALUE: 5 MONEY COMETH Asmussen had morning line favorite in here but was a vet scratch. That leaves him with this colt. Willing to look past a debut that came at a sprint and on the muddy track. Bred to go long. Improves. He had two for this owner and one won by 9 and is a superstar, Cofeve. Works are pretty typical for Cox. Check toteboard. VALUE: 2 AIN'T NO ELMERS Trainer Calhoun is 7 for 18 (39%) with a first timer on dirt sprinting in a MSW for 3YO+ when off at 3-1 or less. Sire is win early blood. The works are sharp here since arriving in mid-December. Gets L1. This is the female family of many G1 turfers led by Rainha Da Be. Love the works coming in. VALUE: 8 SMALL TALK Sib to the dam, Irish Mission, won over \$1M and 900k of that came on the turf. Huge run in debut when 2 nd a head 22-1 odds. Blinkers off after a poor start vs. a similar group in last. Deliberate drills. A) 8,13,14 B) 1,2,6,7,9 C) 3,4,5,10,11,12
5TH FAIR GROUNDS 5TH OPT CLM 50K, 1M 1/8 DIRT 70 1 CHESTERTOWN 6-5 6 RANAAN 9-2 3 SHAKE SOME ACTION 5-1 7 UNTHROTTLED 6-1 PICK: 1 CHESTERTOWN Asmussen runner sold for \$2M. His dam won 943k and won the G1 Ballerina with 103 Beyer. Deeper in the female family is the G1 winner, Stephen Got Even. Top two from last are in G2 Risen Star today. VALUE: 6 RANAAN It used to be that an Asmussen runner who started at Sam Houston would be a claimer. But the purses this year are double. Drew 12 post in debut and won easily, spreading them out behind him. Won both starts sprinting on the grass. Faced a strong field going long on turf 3 back. Really strong works for this and the drill on 2/1 was reportedly excellent. VALUE: 3 MADE YOU LOOK He has never sprinted on the turf going this distance. The last turf sprint was 2 back when 2 nd at Belmont. He faced G1 company at Saratoga and Woodbine vs likes of Got Stormy. He'll be flying on late. He had a firster win for fun on 2/1 here at 7-1. That winner, also MSW sprinting, came from last. The works here are much better. Amoss 38% debut dirt MSW at FG. VALUE: 2 MALAHINI Dam won her first start, at SAR, by over 12 lengths, then won back to back G2 races, all sprinting on the dirt. Trainer Mark Casse won MSW here on dirt with a similar colt (Telekinesis) two years ago. Was even money in last start but she missed the break and she was far back before closing strongly in the lane. 5 for 5 in top 2 at this distance. VALUE: 3 NOTAPRADAPRINCE Moved to Kenneally in November. She's been on off-tracks in all 3 starts since. Willing to give her a look if this is a firm turf course. 9 FAIR GROUNDS 9TH 64 MINESHAFT (G3) 200K, 1M 1/16 1 MOCITO ROJO 8-1 11 PIRATE'S PUNCH 10-1 4 SILVER DUST 5-2 10 CUTTING HUMOR 8-1 PICK: 1 MOCITO ROJO He's won 17 of 28 starts but he's on a 3-race losing streak. 2 of 3 losses came on an off-track. He may not want that. He won two stakes going longer and proven to be game late. He will draft in a good spot early from the rail here. Regular rider ships in for this. Downgrade on a wet track. 2ND: 11 PIRATE'S PUNCH Pretty sharp horse coming into this race. He's won 3 of his last 6, and all 3 were by daylight. He may have the best speed in here and would think Albarado sends him from the wide post draw. Winner 2 back ran third in the 5 th Season at OP and then won in an opt clm 80k last Sun. 3RD: 4 SILVER DUST Comes into this race off of five wins in his last ten starts. Blew out a few of these in his recent start in the G3 Louisiana, a prep for this race. Has a great style. He can sit up near the pace and wait for the speed to tired. He's consistent, loves the distance and has done great here at FG. VALUE: 11 PIRATE'S PUNCH A) 1,11 B) 4,6,9,10 C) 2,3,8	10 FAIR GROUNDS 10TH 61 FG (G3) 150K, 1M 1/8 TURF 2 SYNCHRONY 3-1 4 FACTOR THIS 8-1 6 CLASSIC COVEY 6-1 5 DONTBLAMEROCKET 9-2 PICK: 2 SYNCHRONY Used roughly the same pattern to win this race in '19 and in '18. He ran in graded stakes, laid off and came back to win this race off a break in each of those two years. Shuffled in last and never got into high gear when he was on the rail. Bravo 5 wins, 4 3rds in 9 starts on him. 4 for 5 at FG. 2ND: 4 FACTOR THIS Should come down to who gets the best trip. We know there will be a couple that send here. This one has speed but can sit in the perfect tracking trip. Won three in a row for Cox last year and the 3rd was a pressing the pace win in 98k KD Pr at ELP. Will have every chance turning for home. 3RD: 6 CLASSIC COVEY Should get a great pace flow in here for his furious late move. Mott runner always puts in the late effort. Comes in off a break but has run well fresh in the past. Alvarado rode him for two wins in a row at Bemont in 2017. Best Beyer came in a G2 at GP going 1 ½ back in March. VALUE: 4 FACTOR THIS A) 2,4 B) 5,6,12,13 C) 3,7,8,10	11 FAIR GROUNDS 11TH 54 RCHL ALX (G2) 300K, 1M 1/16 4 IMPECCABLE STYLE 12-1 6 BRITISH IDIOM 8-5 5 TEMPERS RISING 6-1 7 FINITE 2-1 PICK: 4 IMPECCABLE STYLE Trainer McPeck is 4 for 17 (24%) with 7 in the money (41%) last out maiden winner to a graded stakes on dirt going over a mile That includes 30-1 winner of the Grade 2 Holy Bull last Feb, Harvey Wallbanger. This one faded first out but may have bled (L1 next start). Works too good to ignore. 2ND: 6 BRITISH IDIOM Undeclared in 3 starts for Brad Cox. She won G1 Alcibiades in a romp and bested Donna Veloce and Bast in the BC Juv Fillies. Bast, Donna Veloce ran one-two in the G1 Starlet at LRC in their next starts. Cox has bigger goals in mind. She's talented but is vulnerable off the layoff today. 3RD: 5 TEMPERS RISING Four of the top five finishers in the Silverbulletday are in this race. This filly was the only big closer making ground late off of slow fractions. She's fired in every one of her starts. It might be quick enough pace to set up her late kick. Stewart is known for getting bombs into the exacta. VALUE: 5 TEMPERS RISING A) 4,5,6,7 B) 2 C) 1,3	12 FAIR GROUNDS 12TH 74 RISEN STAR (G2) 400K, 1M 1/8 11 SCABBARD 12-1 2 SILVER STATE 4-1 5 MOON OVER MIAMI 10-1 8 ENFORCEABLE 7-2 PICK: 11 SCABBARD Was favored in the G3 Lecomte last out and had an absolutely brutal trip. He was shuffled on the turn, got in behind a wall of runners in the lane and couldn't get a clear run. Had a tough trip in the Iroquois but rallied for a strong 2 nd . Has to negotiate a good trip from the widest post. 2ND: 2 SILVER STATE Slow starts in every one of his 3 races and it really cost him a win in the Lecomte. He passed most of the field when 2 nd but did have to go 6-wide to do so. Dam ran just once but her sib won the '01 Ky Dby (Monarchos). Big field and enough speed for a finisher. A sharp work on 2/3. 3RD: 5 MOON OVER MIAMI There are 2 G1 winners in 2nd generation of the female tree. Music Note won 5 G1's, 1.6M dirt routing. Musical Chimes won 2 G1's, on turf, in early 2000's. This colt had a wide trip in the opt clm in last. An aggressive placement by the conservative Mott. Haven't seen his best yet. VALUE: 5 MOON OVER MIAMI A) 2,5,11 B) 1,8,9,10 C) 3,4,6,7	13 FAIR GROUNDS 13TH 66 RISEN STAR (G2) 400K, 1M 1/8 1 MODERNIST 8-1 10 FINNICK THE FIERCE 10-1 11 MAILMAN MONEY 8-1 8 ANNEAU D'OR 9-5 PICK: 1 MODERNIST Maiden winner last start. Mott took same path with Country House last year. He broke his maiden in 3rd start and then ran 2 nd the very next start in this race at 7-1. 4 next out winners of the start two back. Dam is a half to two BC winners and millionaires (Life is Sweet & Sweet Catomine). 2ND: 10 FINICK THE FIERCE Was bet in his first start but he took zero money in the 3 starts afterwards. Just missed taking the Ky Jockey Club at 88-1 with a big late move. He found traffic in the Lecomte but finished with something left at 14-1. Blinkers come off here. Pace should be on the fast and contested side. 3RD: 11 MAILMAN MONEY Undeclared two for two after a strong, game win here last out at 5-2 odds. Broke slow and was wide in the race but drew away unchallenged earning a strong number. Distance pedigree on the female side, many strong on grass. Trainer having a big meet.
