Returned to win on a class drop at nearly 5-1 in next start. Picks up the 2019 top rider Arrieta. Wide post will set him up well. <b>VALUE: 4 GREAT BLAKE</b> Three of the four starts on this turf this meet were excellent and all long odds. The one time he was bet was two back and he flopped. That was on a soft turf track. Will get the run of the race today. Three straight on the board finishes at this level. Show finisher in last won 6 days ago at this same level. Harr has been riding great. <b>VALUE: 2 FORTNITE DANCE</b> He hasn't been able to break cleanly in the last 4 starts. Was way behind them in his last start but made up big ground in the lane and getting to the winner late. Extra furlong will help him in here. A) 2,5,6 B) 1,4 C) 3,7	<b>CANTERBURY PARK 5 (6:35 CT) 60</b> <b>CLM 20K, 7.5F TURF</b>  3 BENTLEY'S DREAM 5-2 4 FAIRLY HONEST 12-1 5 FROSTY FLIRT 9-2 10 SHE'S FIRE AND ICE 5-1  <b>PICK: 3 BENTLEY'S DREAM</b> Just ran second by a head vs similar in mid August and was unlucky to lose in there at 4-5. Drew the rail in there and with the scratches gets the inside here again. Regular rider is back up in here. <b>VALUE: 4 FAIRLY HONEST</b> Only turf try was in the debut at FG vs a tough MSW group. She came closing in from far back to finish 5 <sup>th</sup> beaten less than 5 lengths. Good effort two back in opt clm company. Won last time vs clm. A) 3,4 B) 5,10 C) 6
<b>CANTERBURY PARK 2 (5:10 CT) 40</b> <b>MDN CLM 7K, 5.5F DIRT</b>  3 WHATDOYATHINK 5-1 4 AZUSA ST. 8-5 6 CHANGING GEARS 2-1 5 WALKERS MEMO 9-2  <b>PICK: 5 WHATDOYATHINK</b> <b>VALUE: 5 WALKERS MEMO</b> A) 3,4 B) 5,6 C) 2	<b>CANTERBURY PARK 7 (7:40 CT) 26</b> <b>CLM 4K, 5.5F DIRT</b>  1 DISTINCT APPROVAL 6-1 7 VERY BOISTEROUS 12-1 9 SASSY SETA 2-1 4 PAPA'S ISLA DOLL 7-2  <b>PICK: 1 DISTINCT APPROVAL</b> She drew the rail two back and won at this level. There is a lot of speed here and while she has speed, as well, she doesn't need the lead to win. Been in the exacta 6 straight. Leading rider up. <b>VALUE: 7 VERY BOISTEROUS</b> Harr took her off the pace in her most recent start which came at 5F on grass. That style would work well in how this race shapes up. She's 5 for 8 in the top 3 at the distance on dirt. Big price here. A) 1,4,7,9 B) 3,6,8 C) 5	<b>CANTERBURY PARK 8 (8:10 CT) 57</b> <b>CLM 10K, 6.5F DIRT</b>  6 AWESOME EMMIT 6-1 4 DROP THE GLOVES 10-1 2 TUCKER TIME 9-2 3 CAMPAIGN SKY 5-2  <b>PICK: 6 AWESOME EMMIT</b> This is a pretty substantial class drop. He's faced some top quality foes here since coming from Fonner. Had to go around a loose horse in last race. He's a 5x winner here. Top jock rides today. <b>VALUE: 4 DROP THE GLOVES</b> Comes out of the same tough race the top choice is out of. He ran 4 <sup>th</sup> in there in a decent effort after pressing a fast early pace. Good form at the low levels in the prior starts. Sneaky price today. A) 6 B) 1,2,3,4 C) 5,7,8	<b>CANTERBURY PARK 9 (8:40 CT) 66</b> <b>MDN CLM 7K, 1M DIRT</b>  2 TIMEINTHETAVERN 5-2 6 AND HE'S LOOSE 7-5 3 SLIM CHANCE 10-1 1 RAISIN CANDY BAR 4-1  <b>PICK: 2 TIMEINTHETAVERN</b> She made a big run to the lead in last but really couldn't run with the class dropping winner late. That looks a lot better since the winner won by 5 over a decent 7k field 6 days ago. Fits here. <b>VALUE: 3 SLIM CHANCE</b> 4 <sup>th</sup> beaten 14 in debut won at mdn clm 25k next while the winner took the Mn Derby by nearly 5 lengths at 6-1. Moves to dirt and drops 12 pounds today with this apprentice rider. Add to the Pick 5. A) 2,6 B) 1,3 C) 4
<b>CANTERBURY PARK 6 (7:10 CT) 68</b> <b>CLM 7K, 1M TURF</b>  5 STITZY 9-5 1 BURGAMEISTER 9-2 4 GREAT SKY 3-1 3 SPIRIT MISSION 10-1  <b>PICK: 5 STITZY</b> Connections drop the MN-bred as we get near the end of the meet. He won 3 of his last 5 and has hit the board in 6 straight (7 of 9 overall). Faced some very good Mn-breds. Stands out today. <b>VALUE: 1 BURGAMEISTER</b> Has run strictly 5F sprints on the grass in last 4 tries on that surface. He won a mile race on the dirt at WRD so added ground is no issue. Saves ground from the rail. Jumps up in third off the shelf. A) 5 B) 1,3,4,6 C) 7,8,9
