

ON THIS DATE (1989) – Northbound Pride won the 1989 Champion Three-Year Old Filly at Canterbury Downs. On July 22, 1989, Northbound Pride won her first career stakes race as she took the \$30k Aquatennial Stakes. She won six times in 1989 and would win four stakes at Canterbury Downs. She is one of thirteen horses in the Canterbury Hall of Fame.

VALUE: 2 SPEEDING KID Somewhat quietly put together a nice career at this track. He's won 169k in 15 starts (on the board 12 times). Was really rolling 2 back to just miss. The winner 2nd a nose in 50k stakes next. Went long in last and had no punch in the lane and faded. She is 2 for 6 at the distance. Mn-bred beat up on Mn-bred company last year. Better. VALUE: 2 VIX VISION There is enough speed in the race for an off-the-pace runner like this one to get a good trip. 16 of 41 in the money in his career and 9 for 19 in the money at the distance. Career best form now. VALUE: 2 ARNOLD'S PATSY She hasn't won yet on the turf but has been close many times. Winner of two of her last 3 starts. Bred to handle the turf and should get quite a bit of pace to run into. Connections win a lot here. Runner-up in last was second here on the turf for a 16k tag two weeks ago. Sire won 853k on the grass as a Grade 1 winner (won the '15 Makers Mark Mile at Keeneland).
