

ON THIS DATE (1985) – In the 1st year of Canterbury Downs, one of the marquee races run was the \$150,000 Canterbury Cup. It was won by 8-1 longshot **BADWAGON HARRY** on August 11, 1985. He shipped in after winning the Grade 2 Michigan Mile and running 2nd in the Grade 2 Cornhusker at Ak-Sar-Ben. He was voted the Canterbury Champion Older Horse of 1985.

 Dropped to this level last week and ran well for third behind two other class droppers. She was getting to the top two but started her run a tad late there and ran out of time. Faced better in the first three starts of her career. She'll get an ideal trip from the inside.

 She ran second in her last start and the start three back to close out the 2020 season. Both were at this lower level. The race in between was on the turf in a MSW and she drew the 12 post and started slowly in there. That race can be tossed. Will be finishing here.

VALUE: 2 HARD TO PARK
 Good effort off the short layoff two back when 4th by 3 at 16-1. Drew a wide post in last and was wide for most of the race. He's a late runner who needs this extra distance and the drop in class will be valuable in here. Could use a fast pace to set up his late kick.

 Was bet to 6-1 in the debut and while he was 5th out of that field of 6, he did finish in front of one of the main foes in here, Angel's Magic. New rider Lindsay takes over here and he comes in with a decent 4F workout on this track. Drop to claiming should help.

VALUE: 5 OVERLY LUCKY
 Last time on the turf was two back and he ran a big race when dead-heated for second at 8-1. Responds well with Quinonez (2 wins, 1 place & 1 fourth). Was third to one of the best runners at the track last out (Thealligatorhunter). His form is very good right now.

 Last two starts were vs. 16k company on the grass and in the mud. The start 3 back was vs. similar to this field and he was 9-1 in there. He tired after the fast fractions he was setting. Has enough speed to get into position. Should get a good trip in this spot.
