Back to dirt and back to Suarez. Made up a bit of ground two back behind a slow early pace. Second time blinkers can be a positive angle. Better on the dirt. VALUE: 6 SWEET LEAF Claimed for 16k five starts ago. Was a 2-1 favorite first off the claim but she stumbled at the start losing any shot in there. Big rider upgrade and move to a new trainer. Just a head behind Chica Difisel two back. Exotics adder. He's run three times, all 3 came on turf. 7 th three back was next out winner Draftable. He beat a viable runner 10 Mister rather easily. Sibs did their best running on the dirt. VALUE: 11 MUST BE A MONSTER Back to back third place finishes puts him in the win discussion here. Taken up two back costing him better. 5 th in the start 3 back from the 10 post in a race that has come back strong. First ran 2 nd for 20K, won for 16k next two. Must look past her last start when facing a strong opt clm group sprinting on wet turf. Faced males two back and away in poor fashion. Connections move to a spot she can win. One to beat today. VALUE: 1 AGUS COLORADAS 2 for the previous outfit. Claimed four back for this tag. Ran on soft footing 3 back when at GP. Carried very wide from widest 9 post two back. Thought rider moved too soon last while wide again. Saves ground today at a price. One win was last week with similar works. Sib to '09 Gotham and Peter Pan runner-up Imperial Council. Check the action. VALUE: 4 HIGHLY EXPLOSIVE Trainer is an excellent 17 for 50 (34%) with a first timer and that includes a win of such here at Tampa. Most wins came at PID. Sire won his debut by 6 on his way to G3 winner. Works typical for a live firster for these connections. A) 1,2 B) 4,5,6 C) 3,7,8

It includes 4 straight and 7 of last 9. This looks like the one to beat in a few ways. There is a lot of speed in here and he will track neatly from the rail. Rider 4 for 6 for trainer. VALUE: 3 ABSALOM All the stats for first off claim for top choice apply here as this is the same trainer and this is also first off claim. Only turf try came on the quirky turf at MNR. First and fifth won right back from that race. (First won 4 of 5 starts). A) 1 B) 3,4,6,7,8 C) 2,5,9,10	6 TAMPA BAY DOWNS R6 (2:52) 81 MSW 20K, 1M TURF 1 FIT FOR A KING 9-2 5 SUNSATON 7-2 7 EYES OF GLORY 6-1 10 VICARAGE 4-1 PICK: 1 FIT FOR A KING Trainer has a good record with debut turf runners going long. He had such a win here this month at TAM and that 6-1 winner was outworked often by this one. Dam won 400k on turf, was 4 th by length in the 2009 G1 Beverly D. VALUE: 7 EYES OF GLORY Came off the layoff and ran evenly as a 9-5 second choice. Major key race 2 back as top three all came right back to win (winner took a stakes). Many of the runners he faced have since won. Breeding is just average for the grass. Efforts 2 and 3 back put him in the mix. 8Y0 is very consistent at this level. He won 65k in 2019 and moved from mid claiming to op clm and back again. Perfect trip. VALUE: 11 JACK B WINKLE Trainer had this runner for this first 2 starts and got a win and runner-up in the debut. Huge run three back at GP when beaten a nose in a 30k claimer. Poor runs last 2 but turf race can be discounted. Rider is at 26% for trainer. A) 6,8,9 B) 3,7,10,11 C) 2,4,5	8 TAMPA BAY DOWNS R8 (3:55) 60 HANDICPA 23K, 1M 3/8 TURF 9 ONAROCK 7-2 2 FAST FIRE 6-1 3 HOPE AGAIN 3-1 7 BOURBON EXTENSION 4-1 PICK: 9 ONAROCK Really bred well for the grass and has fired on it in most of his starts. Really moving well late in last and lost the 4 horse blanket finish. Drew the rail at FG 2 back and split the field vs better. More distance the better this pedigree. VALUE: 2 FAST FIRE Deserves a look consider that he was in the photo for the win vs many here and it was the 1st start off a 4-month break.
