In the money in both starts so far at GP. He received Lasix for the first time last out so he may have bled in the debut. Shuffled but re-rallied in last. 4th from last won at 1M 1/8 MSW at AQU by 5 next (79 Beyer). 5th was nosed out in MSW at GP. Obvious win player in this one.

Keith Desormeaux ridgling hasn't fired in the 3 stakes this year but he was facing much better than what he sees in here. First time Lasix could explain the run in the Southwest last out. Ran well at 7F to 1M at CD last year. Goes back to the maiden winning rider J Graham.

She was last seen running 5th of 14 runners in the G1 BC Juv Fillies Turf. She as bet down to 9-2 after winning 3 straight to start her career. The 4 fillies who finished in front of her were an undefeated Brad Cox filly and 3 Euro's. She has a strong late kick. Obvious contender.

Overall they've hit the board in 8 of 9 with him. There is a lot of speed in here. This one should be tracking perfectly. Saez up for 2 wins on him including 11-1 score in a similar stakes at PIM.</p> <p>VALUE: 11 HIGH CRIME Despite the fact that he has speed and looks like he's best controlling the pace, he actually made up some ground in the stretch all four starts at 5.5F on the turf. Winner of last was third in the BC Turf Sprint previous. Will be moving best in the lane.</p> <p>VALUE: 2 PASS THE CHAMPAGNE A bit of a wildcard in here as she is coming in off a 4-5 maiden win where she won for fun from the widest 10 post. Could be the best distance.</p> <p>VALUE: 1 SANENUS Group 1 winner in Chile is now a Grade 3 winner in the US after she crushed 6 foes at Santa Anita in her most recent start. That was her first without Lasix since the move to the US. Third two back won a stakes at FG for fun. Great workouts.</p> <p>VALUE: 2 UNTREATED This is the female family of \$1.8M winner Lu Ravi and '03 G1 Breeders' Cup Juvenile Fillies winner Halfbridled. Was sold privately for 300k after the flop at 4-5 in the MSW debut. Destroyed the field in the Tampa MSW last out.
