

ON THIS DATE (1990) – On September 2nd, 1990, **LIKELY PROSPECT** lapped the field in the 1st running of the Victor S. Myers Stakes, owned by Mary Surrency, owned by Almar Farms, he drew off to win by over 9-lengths. Surrency trained the top 3 finishers in the race (Memo One and Venture North were 2nd, 3rd). Likely Prospect won the Northern Lights three weeks later.

Iowa bred came here for the grass. He was in same race that Ship It Red was second by a neck in most recent start. This one was just a length back there in a decent effort. Thought he moved a bit too soon but still held in gamely. He'll get the run of the race.

VALUE: 4 SKIPPY'S STRIKE

Trainer Kerri Raven has had a strong meet and has done especially well with turf sprinters. This one is coming out of a close 4th in the race won by Plane Talk. He was closing furiously with a wide trip and just missed. He's 11 of 17 in the money on this turf.

Moves to Mac Robertson here after a pop and stop in the Victor S. Myers last out. That was on a muddy track and given his other awful start on a wet track (6th beaten 14 as the 2-1 favorite) it's possible that he needs fast footing. Think he'll revert to prior form.

Shipper from Prairie Meadows comes in from Iowa due to the lack of a turf course there. Loads of turf in the breeding (sire won the '13 Arlington Million). Both starts came in the 1st two starts of his career in MSW at KD and KEE. Class relief should be helpful.

VALUE: 8 CHAMPS SUCCESS

Decent 4th beaten less than two despite getting in a tight spot with limited room to run last start. It was his first start of the year and should be better in this second off the layoff. Moves to Quinonez and is on the turf for the second time. Presses the pace today.

4YO filly has really carved out a nice career with 4 wins and 160k earned. She won the 2020 Mn Oaks at 10-1 and was a runner-up in the Princess Elaine at 8-1 in the next start. Strong 19-1 win two back in opt clm with Eikleberry up. Love the cutback to 6.5F

VALUE: 3 BERRY GOOD

Mac Robertson and Novogratz Racing team up with this 6 raced filly. She has never missed the board as she has 2 wins, 3 placings and a third. Went wire to wire in last and notice that was her first start with a set of blinkers. Could carry that performance forward.

Sire California Chrome won the '14 Kentucky Derby but breeding was strong for the grass (he won the G1 Hollywood Derby in his lone start on turf). This is a second time starter. The debut was decent when she broke from a tough 10 post and fanned 4-wide.

VALUE: 6 GOLDIE'S DELIGHT

She was in the same race as the top two choices in her last start. She split the field at 5-1 in a middling effort. Her prior turf start was at GP in MSW against top level competition. Eligible to improve. Doesn't face much. She should vie for a minor award today.

Surprisingly little speed in this abbreviated 5F race (normally these are loaded with speed). This 9YO is fast enough early to take the lead. Last win was on this turf (4 back) with this rider wire to wire. Traffic trouble in last eliminated him. Run of the race here.

VALUE: 5 ROCKTIZWAY

Odd running line in last. He's normally up near the lead, at least pressing the pace. They came from a dead last (10 behind) position in last and never got into the race. They go back to Canchari and with a lack of any speed look for him to send from the gate.

PICK: 7 PRETTI TA KELA Mac Robertson filly dropped in for 15k in last start and was third at 2-5 with a rather poor trip under Canchari. Robertson makes a move to Wade today and she drops again. Both rider Wade and trainer Robertson are battling for titles. Gets a better trip.		PICK: 5 I'M A SPECIAL STAR Decent runner-up finish on the major class drop in his last start. The winner was also dropping to that lower level. This one was steadied at a key point in the race. Should show good speed and get a strike spot early. His third start with blinkers off for Cline.		PICK: 7 SUPER CONSTITUTION Mac Robertson trained gelding has run well on turf and dirt. Moves back to the dirt here. Was 2 nd in the two starts routing on the dirt locally. Rider move in here to Quinonez. Overdue to break through at this condition. Robertson competing for the trainer title.	
VALUE: 9 GOING RUNNING TOO She's run second in both of her dirt starts here and has actually run second in 3 of her last 4 on the dirt here going back to last year. She was 54-1 and 23-1 in the 2 runner-up finishes. She's in with Mn-bred's after facing open last out. Very dangerous at a price. A) 6,7,9 B) 1,3,4,11 C) 2,5,8,10		VALUE: 7 BOSS HUGO Broke his maiden here last September from the 12 post at 9-1. Went long at PRM next out and lost that race at the start when he ducked in. Only returned a week ago in an even effort. Looks like he'll move forward in this one. Has some speed to get position. A) 5,7 B) 1,2,6,8 C) 3,4		VALUE: 4 QUANTUM LEAP Was really a non-threat at under 3-1 in the first start here locally. But that was a week ago at 6F. That was a prep to go longer which he gets today.
