The winner and 4 th place finisher ran one-two in a ZIA stakes next start. Third three back at EMD was show finisher on 11/5 that many of these are out of. Closing late. VALUE: 4 WAY TOO CUTE This trainer took over two back and it produced a maiden win for the So Cal shipper. She tried the same allw race that a few others were in and ran 5 th at 23-1 but only a head behind the #2 here. Trainer 42% so far at this meet. VALUE: 3 CHICLE SPARKS Low percentage connections but she has a legitimate shot vs this field. She gets a weight break with apprentice rider up and also Lasix for the 1 st time today. Was running on late in the first local start. Notice 59.2 work on 11/26. A) 6,7,8 B) 3,5 C) 1,2,4,9	3rd - TURF PARADISE R3 51 CLM 4K, 4.5F DIRT 3 OVER EZ 7-2 2 MITCH AND JOHN E 5-1 6 LIL BIT OF THUNDER 3-1 7 BLAZINGULCH 5-2 PICK: 3 OVER EZ He's become a specialist in the short, abbreviated races. Carreno got up in last and he nearly pulled off a 9-1 win from a tough rail draw. Last poor race came 7 back when he was eliminated at the start with bad break. Good trip. VALUE: 2 MITCH AND JOHN E Surprising lack of need-the-lead type of speed in this short race. Had just 1 start in the last 14 months and it was a win on July 3 rd at EMD. Not sure if he has something seriously wrong but if he runs back to EMD form he can win. Van Winkle has two and the other is a closer. 825k purchase had excuses in first 2. Sib to a G3 router. '87 BC Sprint winner Very Subtle in the female tree. Rider is 3 for 4 riding for D Van Winkle. VALUE: 2 SWAYZE Was it the turf or new surroundings in the first local start that nearly fired a 49-1 upset in last. He was beaten a neck to the 8-5 Diodoro favorite. Was getting to that winner late. Will need pace presser to keep the rail honest. A) 1,5 B) 2,3 C) 6
5th - TURF PARADISE R5 46 CLM 6K, 1M TURF 9 PERCY FAWCETT 7-2 6 BAY AREA 5-2 1 BOB'S ALL IN 3-1 2 SURPRISINGLYPERFECT 10-1 PICK: 9 PERCY FAWCETT This is a big drop in class after he ran third from the rail in an op clm 10k at nearly 11-1. Was facing better in New Mexico. Notice the last time at this 6k level, he won. Turf win came at GG in 2017 in a 10k claimer at 6-1. Fits here. VALUE: 6 BAY AREA Another appearance for trainer who's hitting 42% for the meet, 27 wins! Ran 2 nd in last, a similar race to this, at 9-1 odds. He came up the rail and ran out of time. The winner got loose on lead at 15-1 and forgot to stop. Major shot. A) 1,6,9 B) 2,4 C) 3,7,8	6th - TURF PARADISE R6 53 CLM 3K, 4.5F DIRT 1 TUSCANY BEAUTY 1-1 3 TWO STEPS OF GLORY 8-1 4 SHARP DRESSED GAL 6-1 2 SINCERE WARNING 5-1 PICK: 1 TUSCANY BEAUTY Would normally look to beat a runner like this, taking such a dramatic drop to rock bottom. But this trainer has a 33% strike rate on this move. Has the best speed and draws the rail today. Will be tough to catch if physically ok. VALUE: 3 TWO STEPS OF GLORY Dangerous as the "other" runner for a super trainer, Silva, who also has the rail favorite. She was only half behind her back in Feb here and was gaining late. Is 13 for 19 in the money at this track. Rider aboard in ASD win 5 back. A) 1 B) 2,3,4,7 C) 5,6,8	7th - TURF PARADISE R7 64 CLM 3K, 1M DIRT 4 DAWNS MORNING 2-1 8 HIT THE DECK 4-1 5 IF YOU WANT IT 3-1 3 PERFECTLY SEASONED 6-1 PICK: 4 DAWNS MORNING The Hastings Park shippers have run well here at this meet. The lone win at the meet for this trainer dropped out of higher at HST. Claimed for 4k three back so the move to this level makes sense. Will enjoy the softer spot here. VALUE: 8 HIT THE DECK Runners who have been competitive at the 8500 level at this track usually win on the class drop to 3500. There's a big discrepancy in that class move here. While mainly a turfer of late, her debut was a win on dirt with Haar up. A) 4,8 B) 3,5 C) 2,6,7	8th - TURF PARADISE R8 43 CLM 6K, 1M TURF 4 FLOWER BEACH 4-1 6 PACIFIC NIGHTS 20-1 9 BENTLEY'S SHOW 6-1 5 SPIRIT MISSION 12-1 PICK: 4 FLOWER BEACH This trainer won 5 straight before 2nd a head with his last starter. This one was a multiple CBY allowance winner before something went wrong. Faced much better in both starts off a layoff here. Is 11 of 15 in exacta on the turf. VALUE: 6 PACIFIC NIGHTS If this trainer wants to know why she is 0 for 30 this year, only has to look where this one has been consistently placed. Solid 3 rd two back for this tag but every start around it has been in either stakes or opt cl. Better fit here. A) 4 B) 2,5,6,9 C) 1,3,7
