She was a fading ninth going long at KD 2 back but that was a stronger field and that track can be tough to handle. Passed a few in last and worked well since then. VALUE: 8 SACRE BLEU Sire won 2.2M and his wins included G1 BC Mile and the G1 4Stardave (both on turf). Trainer has had just 19 starters with 12 wins in 66 starts (18%). His last two debut were 1 st (12-1) and 2 nd (12-1).
