

**ON THIS DATE (1986)** – On June 29, 1986, the first St. Paul Derby was run. ESPN carried the race and made 72-1 outsider **CHEAPSKATE** the Bud Longshot. Cheap skate beat favored Broad Brush by a nose in a fantastic race. The win put Canterbury (and the ESPN Bud Longshot) on the map. The \$146 winner triggered one winning ticket in the p6 paying \$148,000.

**PICK: 3 ANGEL'S MAGIC**

All of these are first time starters so the breeding & trainer trends are critical. The trainer and owner had the half sib (Molly's Angel) debut in a similar MSW here last year. She won by over 13 lengths. The drills were very similar to these. Leading rider is up today.

**VALUE: 5 JACKS WILLIE**

Dam was unraced but she has three sibs who were graded stakes winners. All 3 of those were basically turf runners (Dreaming of Anna won two G2's on turf at SAR and was third in the '09 BC Mile on turf). New trainer to CBY. Pay attention to action on the board.

**PICK: 1 PROMISING SHOES**

The race is full of speed and this is going to be the deepest closer. This track favors early speed but it will be tougher on the speed in this spot. 4<sup>th</sup> at 58-1 three back in a rich Ark-bred stakes. Definitely has improved for Greg Tracy. 8 for 14 in the top 2 at CBY.

**VALUE: 4 CANDY COVE**

The last time this one was on a fast dirt track came 5 back when third at Tampa. The race prior he went nuts up front and drew off at 8-5. Mn-bred has a bit of speed but should end up in a great stalking spot here. Likes to win (9 for 34). 4 wins at the distance.

Has the exact same worktab as North Arm Baby (1<sup>st</sup> race today). Bethke not very proficient with 2YO first time starters but not many in here are. Dam is a sib to Buccherio (won over \$1M sprinting on both turf & dirt). Aggressive gate rider. Check for any tote action.

**VALUE: 7 NU NU**

This is another one with a barnmate who has exactly the same worktab as one in the first race today for Kerri Raven (Jacks Willie). Check on how he finishes in there. Sib (Wrong) won a MSW in debut in 2011 at Penn. Another sib (Flowers for Lisa) won 500k routing.

Decent run in the debut at 6F. That race looked like a prep for longer. Major route influence both sides of the family tree. Was the winner in last despite a slow start but he ducked in severely in the lane and tossed Canchari. Expect him to make a stretch run.

**VALUE: 1 FLIMFLAM MAN**

He's had excuses in all 3 starts. Was 33-1 in the debut at OP but was slow out of the gate on a sloppy track. Off slow and pulling in the start two back going just 6F. Finally added distance and ran on for 2<sup>nd</sup> on turf. 2<sup>nd</sup> dam on female side won 265k mostly dirt routing.

**PICK: 4 JOE JACKSON**

Was favored in a similar spot last time out but tired to 4<sup>th</sup> after pressing the pace. Two runners have run back. 6<sup>th</sup> ran 2<sup>nd</sup> at 6-1 in a 5k claimer at PRM. 7<sup>th</sup> ran 2<sup>nd</sup> here last Tue at 18-1 for 4k. Has been in the top 2 in 4 of 8 at the distance. He has a bit of tactical speed.

**VALUE: 5 TICK TACK MO**

Apprentice rider couldn't get him close enough last out at PRM and he tired in the lane. The runner who ran 2<sup>nd</sup> to him two back (Go Get That) ran 2<sup>nd</sup> here in an opt clm by a length to win machine Unleash the Beast. 4x winner already this year. Class drop helps.

**PICK: 8 SHE'S XTREMELY HOT**

Leading trainer Mac Robertson has two in here (also has the rail runner). This one came running late last out at 3-1 to pick up the place in first on turf. Broke slowly in every start but she has made up for it with a late run. Will get the pace she needs to close into.

**VALUE: 3 PRINCESS RENEE**

She may have the best pedigree for the grass of any runner in the race. She ran well enough here on turf as a 2YO when 4<sup>th</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> in MSW with the same rider up as is up today. Trainer winning 30% so far at this meet. Think she'll be overlooked in the betting here.

**PICK: 1 HOLY MUCHACHO**

Last time he was routing on a fast track was 3 back at TUP. That was a strong race. The winner returned to run 2<sup>nd</sup> by a neck in an allowance at AZD. 4<sup>th</sup> from that race (Tequila Blanco) won here for 5k and beat a few in here. Trainer is 6 for 20 (30%) 2<sup>nd</sup> off a claim.

**VALUE: 2 WACO KID**

Beat a few of these when 4<sup>th</sup> to One Tough Charlie in his last start. He's routed a few times at other tracks and done ok. Trainer has had a cold meet so far this year but has been known to strike with longshots in spots like this. Poor start two back. Looks an overlay.

The only time this one sprinted on a fast track was in the debut. She crushed them at nearly 50-1 with a big wide move from the 10 post. Had little left late in any of the 3 starts since but those were on turf, routing and on an off-track. Expect to see much more today.

**VALUE: 4 SAILING ALONG**

Lightly raced filly fired in both starts on fast dirt. She was 4<sup>th</sup> two back from the 10 post on a sloppy track. The winner beat open class allw next and had been a strong second in the Northern Lights Debutante as a 2YO. Her dam and 3 sibs picked up checks in stakes.

**PICK: 1 MAKIN DRAMA**

Muddy track and sluggish break in the debut but was only beaten a little more than 3 in a strong mdn race there. 1<sup>st</sup>, 4<sup>th</sup> and 6<sup>th</sup> all came back to hit the board in their next starts. Winner of last start was off at odds of 2-5 after being beaten a neck in a tough MSW at RP.

**VALUE: 2 RUNAMOK**

Comes out of the same race as the top pick. He was about ¾ of a length more than 3 in a strong mdn race at the start of the debut at RP. Trainer wins a lot of QH races here and has hit the board in 7 of 9 starts this meet. Sire was 921k and was a Grade 1 winner.

Last start, and first at CBY, looking much better in light of wins coming back for the top two finishers. The winner beat allowance company as the 2-1 fav next. Runner-up beat maidens at the same level as a 1-2 favorite next. Faced better in first three starts.

**VALUE: 5 QUEEN OF DA NORT**

She has run a few races that puts her in the mix in this spot. Runner-up in her second start was good. Ducked in next time out and lost her chance as the 3-5 favorite. Dwelt and shied break in the next two. She's rounding into form. Dam was a stakes winner.
