Two outside horses likely to be out front early. This one ran behind very fast fractions in last (only sub :45 half of that day). Could find himself in a great spot in the early going. Third off the break today. VALUE: 9 SOUTHSIDER Ran 3rd in last at 42-1. The race he exits is coming back strong. The winner came back to win a 12k claimer at 4-1 (90 Beyer) and 7 th won at this 8k level in his next start at 4-1 (81 Beyer). 5 of 6 that returned hit the board 2 back. Will be running late. Sib to a winner of 405k, 4 of 7 routing, and stakes winner, America's Tale. Found right field. VALUE: 1 GOLDEN RULE HAVEN Ran third in a similar spot at CD to start his career. Lost all chance two back from the poor start but still beat four runners home. 6 th from last, Georgia Deputy, won back by 5 over some of the runners here. Rider gets them to relax. Will save ground. Was off slow on the comeback last out at 14-1 vs similar. Two of four to have come back won (winner at 12k claiming with a 90 Beyer, 7 th at the same level with an 81 Beyer). Needs to break better to win this. VALUE: 8 PETE MARWICK Claimed three back for 7500 and faced a couple of decent fields at MVR. Winner 2 back won an allw next out. 6th won a 5k claimer at TP at 5-1 next. Winner of last won an alw by 6 (80 Beyer). He'll close from far off the pace on the cutback here. Ran on well in the start 3 back after a bothered start. Was a key race two back. Winner and 8 th place finisher won back (8 th was PR Radio Star and he beat 3 foes today). Back to sprint. VALUE: 5 LOUDEN'S GRAY Ran evenly in last and was about 3 back of Bajan Cash at 13-1. Tends to nibble at this level and often outruns his odds. 3rd in a key race two back. Winner won a 20k claimer next (81 Beyer) and runner-up won a starter allowance next (93 Beyer). He was game in defeat in both of his last 2 starts. Last winner trained by Brad Cox was dropping out of the 150k Smarty Jones. Might actually be better sprinting so cutback here makes him a big player. VALUE: 2 LIAM'S PRIDE Added blinkers two back and moved to a sprint. He ran a strong 3rd to a first timer for Asmussen. Runner-up was another 1 st timer (Robertson) and took betting in there. Professional winner in last as the favorite. Sib to 1.2M winner Morning Line. Winner of that race was a first timer who was bet down to 3-1 for Brendan Walsh. 4 th beaten five ran 2 nd in a MSW next at 12-1 at FG. Might need the pace fast and contested for her late run. VALUE: 10 TIPAZAR Cuts back in distance after she finished last at a mile at 9-2 odds. Was off slow in there and tired late. Makes only her 3 rd start since June and encouraged to see Talamo remain. Notice she was 7 clear of third two back. Sire was third a length to Tonalist in 2014 Belmont Stakes and bred for this distance. Is moving in the right direction. VALUE: 1 TURNSTONE 2 very good starts sandwiched around 2 poor starts. Notice she drew the rail and broke slowly in both poor efforts. She is 1 for 1 vs. Ark-breds. Her pedigree leans to routing.
