The leading trainer here, Robertino Diodoro, is hovering around 40% at the meet. He is 47 for 100 (47%) with 77 in the money (77%) with a last out winner in a low level clm at TUP, CBY and when the off odds are 2-1 odds or less. <b>VALUE: 5 FLASH ATTACK</b> Same connections as the top choice. It appears that Diodoro has this race surrounded. Last two races on a sloppy track. He's not been in the exacta from his 7 starts on an off-track. The pace could be quick and could set him up perfectly for a stretch run. He exits a turf race. This should help him as the pedigree is a bit more dirt than turf. Winner two back won in a 30k clm at PRM. Runner-up won a MSW at IND next start. <b>VALUE: 2 TWISTED DIXIE</b> Arkansas-bred has only faced statebred company at Oaklawn so far. First two starts off the break came with blinkers but he was rank and they came off. He didn't care for the route four back. They only paid 11k for her and she was off a year and a half so the move to 10k claiming makes sense. 8 horses from last race ran top 3 next (3 wins). <b>VALUE: 5 ARNOLD'S PATSY</b> Trainer Rhone is the only trainer who has trained horses at Canterbury since the track opened (he had 3 horses on the first day of racing in 1985). She sat last early behind :25.2 and :49.2 fractions. That is far too slow for a closer. Only on the board 4x from 18 races so far but twice in 6 starts on fast dirt (including her lone win). Most of her starts have been vs better foes. <b>VALUE: 6 TOUGHENOUGHTOSTART</b> She has a good record on a fast dirt track (1 win and 4 in the money from 5 starts) but has run poorly on a wet track or turf (0 for 3 none in the money). Prior at Turf Paradise were pretty good despite getting wide trips. Back to regular rider in here. Tired going long on an off-track two back. She faced male runners last out. Rider has won 3 of 5 when riding for Riecken. Sharp bullet drill on May 22. Check betting. <b>VALUE: 6 ADDED DIAMONDS</b> One of two in here for trainer Bernell Rhone. Both of them have a chance to get a share. 5YO mare was a solid runner-up at 82-1 four back in her first start w/ this rider. Beat the top choice two back in the same race vs males. Was slow to get room to run on the inside in that race at 1 mile. The prior starts at Tampa were vs better foes on the grass there. She has the higher speed figures. <b>VALUE: 8 MIZZANNA</b> Trainer doesn't have a win this season but all three of her starters hit the board (including this one). 3 <sup>rd</sup> start off the layoff and moves back to the grass. She just missed when 2 <sup>nd</sup> at 16-1 at GG vs. 20k claiming and was third at same level a few starts later. Winner of last was the even money Diodoro with back class. Eikleberry is aboard.

This one ran poorly off the layoff twice in '19 and '20 so it wasn't a surprise that he needed a race off the break this year. He set the fast pace in the race the top choice was second. There is speed in here so he might just rate a bit like he did in three prior starts.			Has speed going a bit longer. Was on the turf in the start two back but had to duel with other speed like comeback winner Rental Pool. She has been in the money in 3 of 6 on the grass. Trainer started slowly but has been more live lately. Tracks out wide today.
