

ON THIS DATE (1990) – PRINCESS ELAINE won 8 times at Canterbury Downs from 1987 - 1990. But her 3rd place finish in the G3 \$150,000 Lady Canterbury Stakes on May 26, 1990 cemented her place in the Canterbury Hall of Fame. That marked the first time a Minnesota-bred hit the board in a graded stakes. The race was won by the millioinaire Fieldy.

His form is solid right now. Can go right to the front of rate just a bit off the speed. 5th in last ran 2nd next out in an opt clm 20k at KEE. Winner was 4th in Bosselman at Fonner. She might find a home on the grass.</p> <p>VALUE: 1 LILFEATHEREDINDIAN Her sib, Starry Pursuit, was a speedball sprinting on the gras in California. She won the a stakes at Hollywood Park on the grass at 6F. This one was a 46-1 winner here in July at 5F on turf. It seems as if turf is what she wants. Willing to look past turf last out (which he's not bred). 2 solid local works.</p> <p>VALUE: 5 MRS. D'S CONCERTO Mare facing males in here. She breaks quick and has good speed but has had trouble finishing in most of her races. Speed figures are very good in comparison to the others in here. Could be brave if allowed to relax up front. However, he is still dangerous and this one has been hindered by poor starts and traffic trouble. Was allowed to go way too fast too early in last. He went 45.4 for the half and rightfully tired late. There are other speed types in here but none that need the lead to win. The trainer, rider are going to get hot sometime this meet. Form was just ok when they moved to the turf here at 5F last summer. He was game in the two wins (one at 12-1). Might not care for the Tampa surface (ran poorly there in 2020, as well).
