

ON THIS DATE (1986) – SMILE, owned by Frances Center of Minneapolis, had run second in the 1985 Breeders' Cup Sprint. On July 13, 1986, Smile made his 2nd appearance at Canterbury Downs a winning one when he held on to win the Canterbury Cup. He won the Breeders' Cup Sprint later that year and was voted the '86 Champion Sprinter.
