**PICK: 2 ROSEHILL ROAD**  
 Bernell Rhone filly looks long overdue after 3 huge runs in a row on the drop into maiden claiming. In fact, she has hit the board in all 4 of her starts for a tag. Really doesn't face much. Butler back aboard. It would take something unforeseen to get her beat.

**VALUE: 6 I CAME TO SHAME**  
 This one is the most likely filly to upset the choice if that one gets beat. She ran in a MSW on the grass in the debut and promptly threw her head at start of that race and was off last. Drops in class for this and has a 4F work coming in. Likely bottom of exacta.

**PICK: 3 DIGITAL STAR**  
 Considered the rail runner but he was a vet scratch since his last so something amiss there. This one was in a key race 2 back when 5<sup>th</sup> after going very wide in there. 6<sup>th</sup> in last was nosed out at 9-1 here last Sunday. Diodoro is at 30% with a last out winner.

**VALUE: 4 RUSTY CAGE**  
 Speedball comes off the turf where he is 0 for 7 in his career. Last time on dirt was two back when he was off slow then checked late in opt clm company at 13-1. Has had many turf or off-tracks lately. He's going to have the lead here with a good speed rider.

**PICK: 10 WILL THE THRILL**  
 Trainer Padilla is 3 for 7 with debut 2YO starters here (between '20 and '21). The winners works were very similar to this one. Dam a half to three-time Grade 2 winner Lead Story. Deeper in the female tree are 2 millionaire routers (Unbridled Elaine, Glitter Woman).

**VALUE: 2 SPEEDY DAREDEVIL**  
 Minnesota-bred is another 1st timer for Padilla. He has been working in tandem with the top pick. The sire was a sensational two-year old (he won the G1 Champagne as a juvenile). This is the first time LA Valenzuela has ridden for Padilla. Check the betting.

**PICK: 1 PRINCESS RENEE**  
 She was a 25-1 runner-up two back when she was a fast closing filly in the lane to just miss. Public had her as the 3-1 favorite at this distance last out and she was again getting there late only to finish 2nd. Trainer & owner are having a big meet. Saves ground.

**VALUE: 3 METAPHAR**  
 She started her career at Santa Anita turf routing. That is a tall task for a 3YO filly. Was 7-1 in the other turf race but fell over a fallen rival. Last two starts came off the turf. Eikleberry off but apprentice up and a weight allowance. Might prefer to be on grass.

 Favored in all 3 of her local starts for Diodoro. She won once (two back) and was seocnd in the other 2 starts. Must respect anything Diodoro puts out on the track and this one will come running late into a decent pace. Winner of last was a big class dropper.

**VALUE: 10 REMARKABLE CHARM**  
 She came running on late to finish third in the race the top choice was second. This mare was about 5 behind the top choice in there. Apprentice rider is up and she drops 5 pounds. Would benefit most if pace is fast. 13 of 20 in the money at this distance.

 She looked to have the debut in the bag before she bore out badly and eliminated herself. Came back out of that race and ran a solid second on the dirt some 9 clear of third. Dam won 7 of 15 starts in her career. Think there is major upside w/ this 4YO filly.

**VALUE: 3 CHARLIES MISSILE**  
 Favored in last and surprisingly backed right out of it to finish a bad last. That race was not in line with her other starts so something must have happened in there. Dam produced the stakes placed Lil Ninja (sprinting on dirt). Top rider is up. Forgive last start.

Notice she outgamed the top choice in the 6<sup>th</sup> race today so see how she does. It was 9 back to 3<sup>rd</sup>. The Beyer was just 55 but not sure the posted fractions are correct. Sib to multiple stakes winner Clickbait.</p> <p><b>VALUE: 8 STYLIN N PROFILIN</b> Comes off the turf for Valorie Lund. Last time on a dirt track came three back when she was beaten a neck when 4<sup>th</sup> in a blanket photo. She gets the top rider back for the second time. Has hit the board 5 of 11 over this dirt track. That is 3 straight wins for this one. Despite the 10 length win 3 back at 1-9, he remains up for a tag here. Looks like the one they'll have to beat here.</p> <p><b>VALUE: 6 BIG LEAGUE BENNY</b> Claimed away from Diodoro out of a win two back. He really hasn't run a bad race in a long time. May not really care for the off track that he got last out or maybe the barn change was the difference. He'll get plenty of pace to close into. It will be 5 straight if he loses here. Game effort pressing the pace in last as he couldn't get to the speed who was dropping in class for that race. He came back to run 3 back in an alw at 45-1 next. Eikleberry had options.</p> <p><b>VALUE: 2 HOLDENTIGHT</b> Straight MSW dropper is the only one with a chance to beat the top choice. Faced better in his 4 starts so far and wasn't disgraced. Beyer numbers need to improve to beat the big favorite but the drop will make him a tough beat here.
