Winner of the 30k Manitoba Oaks is no joke (2 back). She's 9 for 9 so far in her career. Nice worktab for this comebacker. Arrieta was up in last win. <b>VALUE: 2 CABLOOSIE BAY</b> Trainer Tony Rengstorf has been on fire at this meet. His horses never ran a step this winter/spring at OP and WRD but as in 2017, he was looking to the CBY meet. Shuffled in last on turf. Bred for the dirt. He has 6 wins on the grass but proved two back that dirt is just find (7 of 11 in the top 3 on main track). Trainer wins at a high % here and is 2 for 3 at the meet already. <b>VALUE: 3 TAPSOLUTE</b> OP shipper split the field in last start vs 40k claiming company. The winner won back for 50k at CD. 9 <sup>th</sup> beaten 15 won in a starter at CD at 14-1 earlier this month. Doesn't win out of turn but faced better. Check the betting. <b>VALUE: 3 WHO'S FOOLING WHO</b> Nice finish for second on opening day at 34-1. He made up ground on a track that was favoring speed. The winner was bet down on a class drop and was never in doubt. Repeat puts her in the win mix. Clearly the one to beat. <b>PICK: 3 RENTAL POOL</b> 2nd last out as her stablemate stumbled and was eliminated steadying as the 1-5 favorite. Won MSW wire to wire on the grass 3 back. Not a ton of turf pedigree but is not facing much. Top local trainer. A) 7 B) 1,3,4,6 C) 2,5

This one exits a strong MSW where she split the field at 19-1. Eikleberry stays aboard in here. <b>VALUE: 10 WEE MS. BURNZIE</b> Another one dropping out of MSW here. She was 8 <sup>th</sup> of 10 runners at 38-1 in her first local start but that effort is better than it may appear. She stumbled out of the gate before pressing the quick pace. Exits a key race (Nora's Legacy and Lady Hideaway ran 7 <sup>th</sup> & 9 <sup>th</sup> there and they both came back to win at this meet. Winner 2 back beat outside runner (Creative Art) a bit later on at TUP. <b>VALUE: 1 OMEN OF CHANGE</b> Claimed in last start at OP for 6,250. He nibbled vs. bottom-level claimers there this spring. Those lower level types can be tough when they ship elsewhere. Is going to be closing. Good young rider up.
